Twenty-Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time

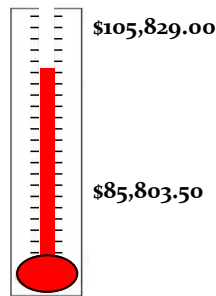

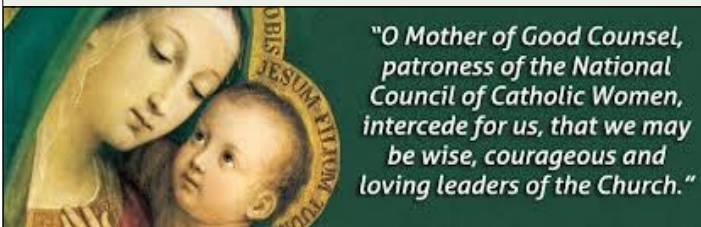
Ministry News

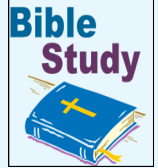

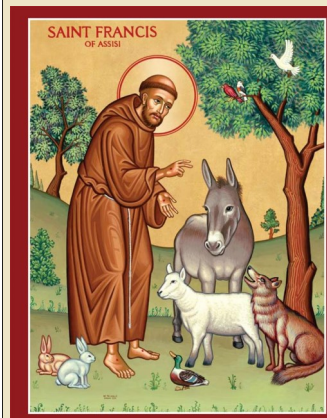

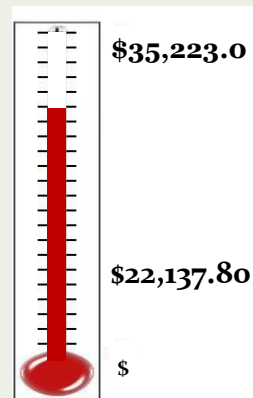
