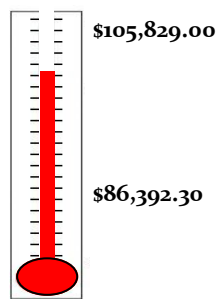

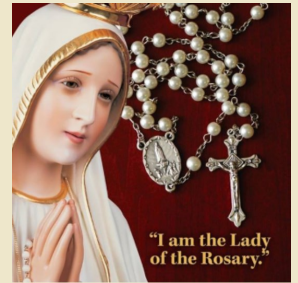

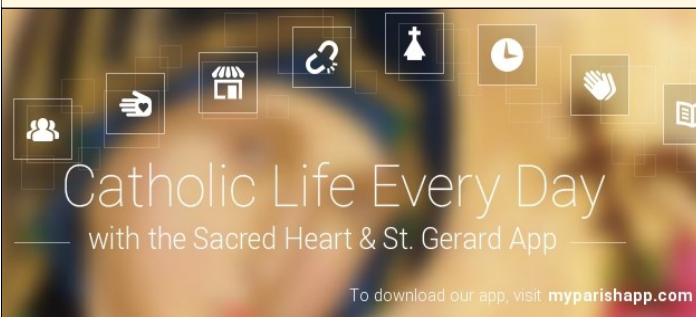

Boost your Brain Power

Recent book by **Dr. Oz: FOOD CAN FIX IT** presents ways to sharpen your mind, keep Neurons active, and improve memory.

Blocking name of a friend or what day it is, is not unusual; it is a natural part of aging. Not a panic. Studies show memory loss scares more people than a threat of heart attack.

Dr. Oz claims some prevention and slowing may be possible. He writes:

1. Exercise, try for 20-30 minutes a day to reduce risk.
2. Push your mind. Take class in crafts, language, dance.
3. Feed yourself "right" fats. Omega 3 is in fish, walnuts, cauliflower.
4. Dark chocolate, tea, red wine, blueberries protect against inflammation to protect cells.
5. Plant based foods. Most sources recommend dinner plate divided into 1/2 vegs, 1/4 protein (fish, meat), 1/4 grains.
6. A 30 second brain booster is to chew cinnamon gum.

I have not read the book but it seems like common sense and it can't hurt but might help!

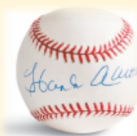

DRAWING FOR HANK AARON AUTOGRAPHED BASEBALL



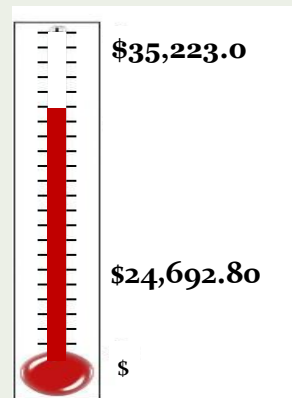
