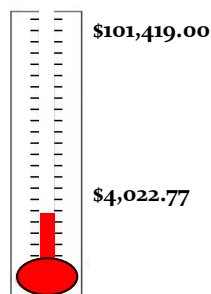

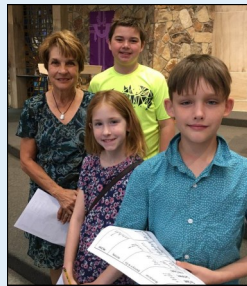

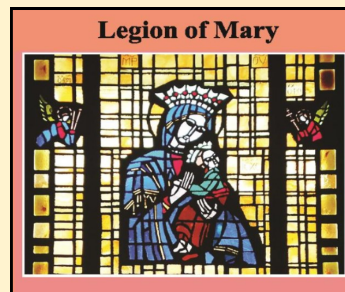
Loretta will still be serving the sick by taking the Eucharist to people in the hospital when needed.

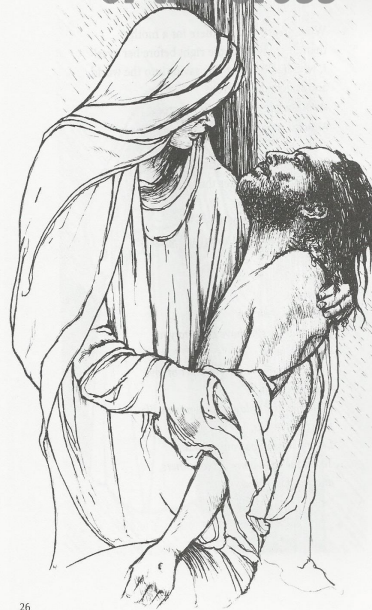

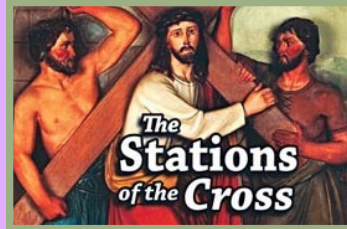

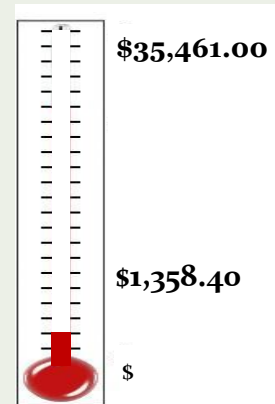
