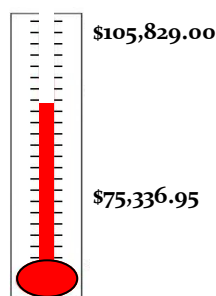

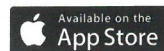

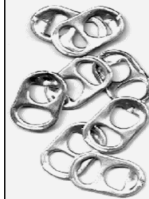

ALUMINUM POP TAB COLLECTION



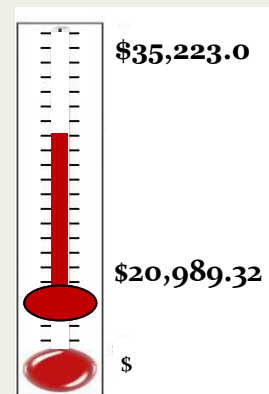

St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) Conference Quarterly Snapshot

During April-June, receipts totaled \$12,558 of which \$10,516 were from begging. Expenses were \$13,378 plus \$2,136 operating expenses. We had to replace

one of two freezers.

SVdP delivered groceries at a cost of \$8,456 to 586 households of 1,590 persons, 30% of whom were children.

The conference gave 41 families utility bill assistance (\$3,835) and 49 families transportation help (\$468). It provided 25 families medications, emergency lodging and miscellaneous services.

Comparing this period to same last year, we note a trend toward more persons living in single households--we served -4% fewer households but +17% number of persons. The number of households picking up groceries (instead of being delivered to) grew (107 cf. 64).

Volunteers totaling 137 gave 1,318 hours of their time and drove 12,527 miles, cheerfully serving our neighbors in need.

How might you help? Prayers, contributions, volunteering. The Lord hears the cry of the poor and we are His instruments.
