**17th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

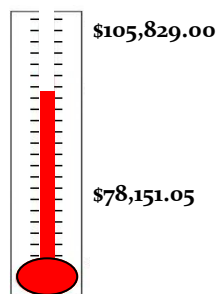

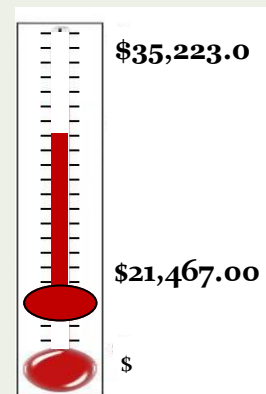
