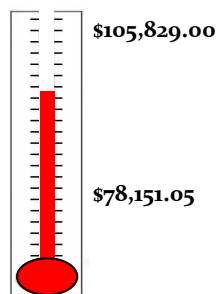

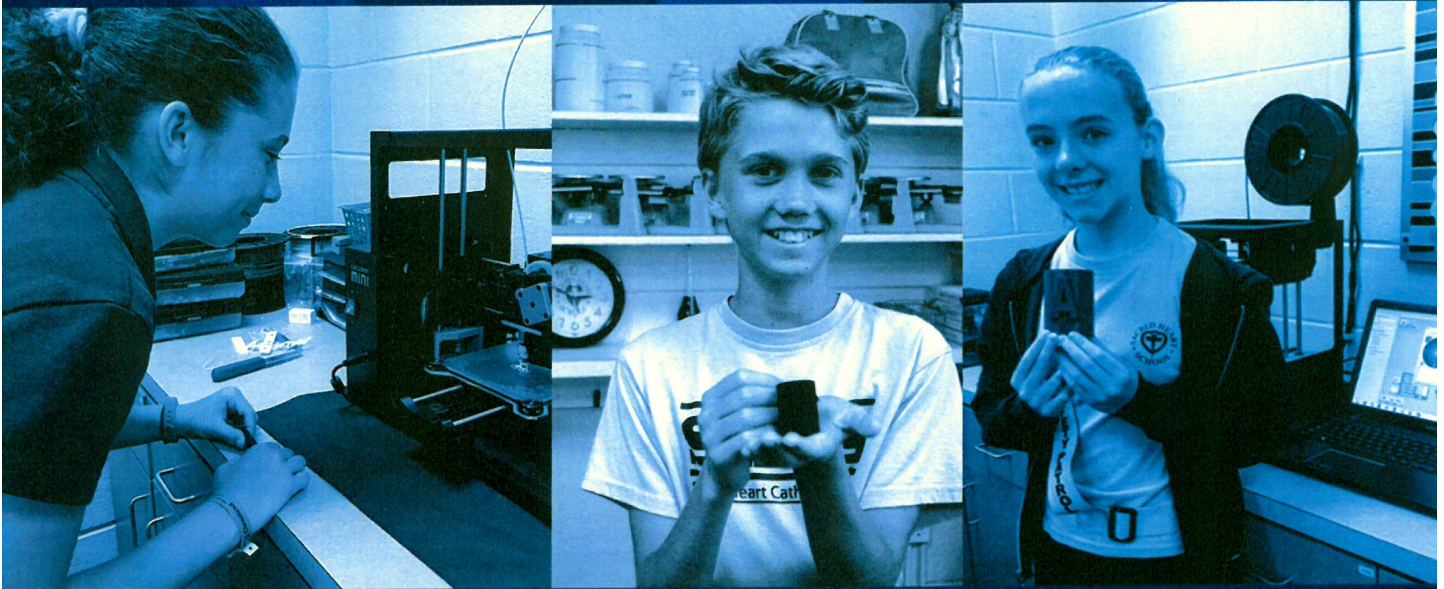

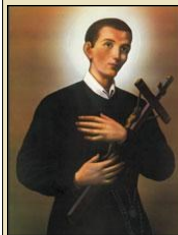

ALUMINUM POP TAB COLLECTION



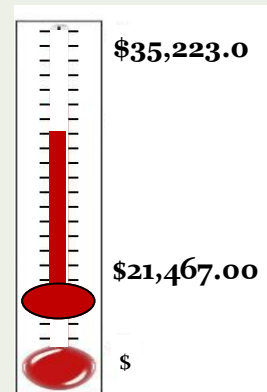

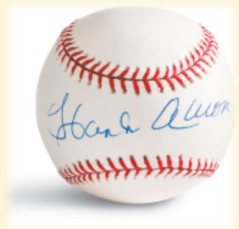
