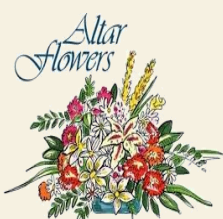

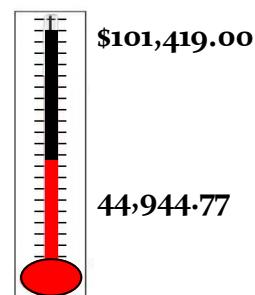

**“Light of Faith Missionary Discipleship Award”**

Eight young writers from Sacred Heart Catholic School and the Diocese of Orlando Student Ace Reporting Program brought honor to their school by winning the coveted “Light of Faith Missionary Discipleship Award” for 2018. Mentored by Mrs. Maria Bilodeau, Ace Reporters Matthew M., (Grade 8) Melina M., (Grade 8) Jackson C., (Grade 7) Madeline R., (Grade 7) Kaileigh M., (Grade 7) Patrick M., and Thomas M. (both Grade 6) wrote from the heart and wrote stories about people and events that reflected charity and discipleship.

Since schools or individuals cannot apply for this award, it came as a sweet surprise to the principal Mrs. Shelley Niswonger! In the words of the Media and Communications Office of the Diocese of Orlando, Sacred Heart School Ace Reporters “moved them by the missionary discipleship modelled in all of their articles.” They added, “it is something that is often hard to teach if not naturally present” and was pure joy to discover through our student writers.

This is the school’s second Light of Faith Award for Ace Reporting, the first one having received in 2014, the school’s first time to join as student reporters.

How often does anyone meet a family who is always willing to help and serve others? The good news is we have a family of four in our school and parish. When asked, John and Beth said “We don’t mind. Our family enjoys helping others and almost always, we do it together so whatever comes up, we are still together and make it a fun family time!” John and Beth also said that serving and assisting at Mass are a great opportunity to spend quality time together, away from electronics, most especially.



Parishioners for nine years now, John and Beth send their twins to Sacred Heart Catholic School finishing seventh grade this year. John Calvo is also a volunteer coach for junior basketball team at Sacred Heart. Both are very active in school as altar servers and safety patrols but Jackson loves writing and is one of the eight Ace Reporters who was just awarded the “Light of Faith Missionary Discipleship Award.”



More than being students at Sacred Heart and serving the Church, twins Allison and Jackson are always encouraged by their parents John and Beth to reach out and show compassion to the less fortunate in the community. Jackson and Allison have recently introduced their own fundraising initiative to feed the hungry which they called “Calvo’s Bottles for Change” aimed at providing funds to the school’s homeless awareness student-led project the “Parker’s Project.”

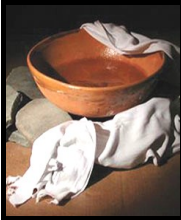

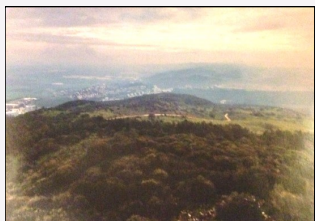

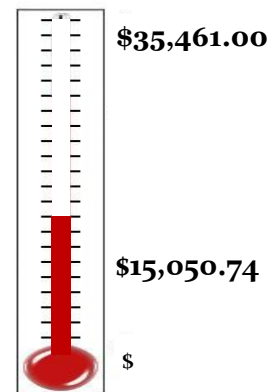

## ALUMINUM POP TAB COLLECTION

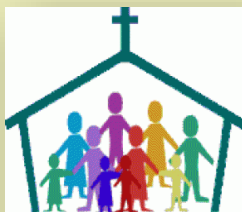
