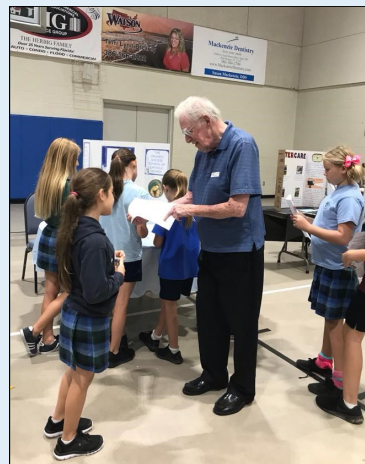
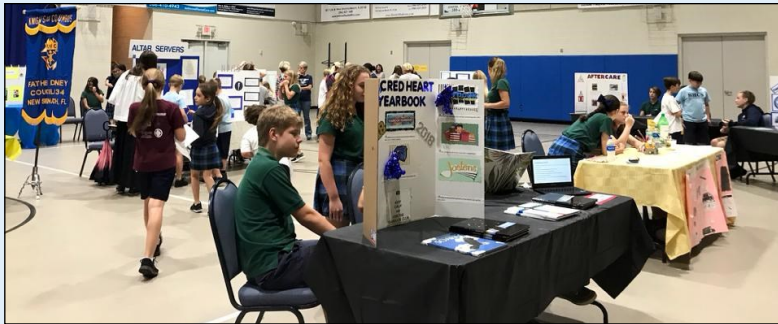
SHS MINISTRY FAIR - "A Vocation to Serve"

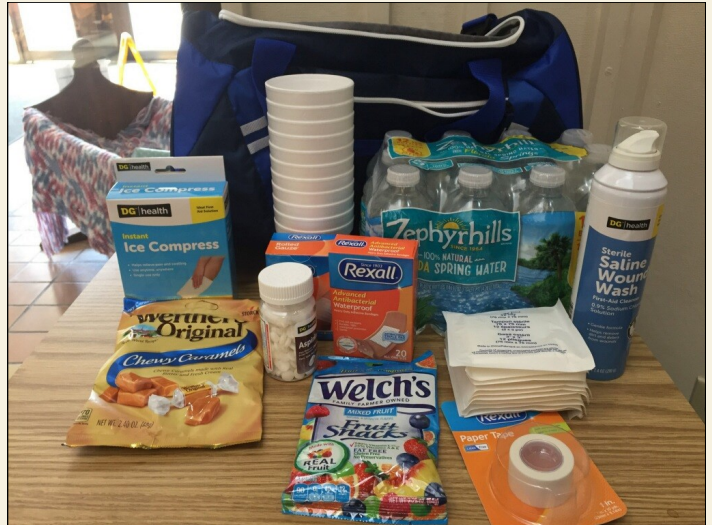

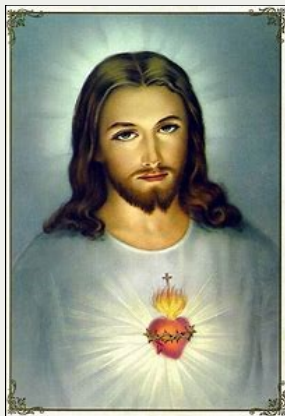

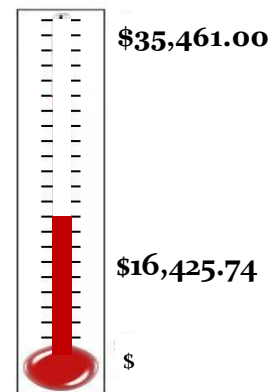

ALUMINUM POP TAB COLLECTION

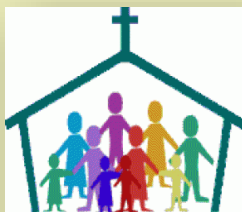
