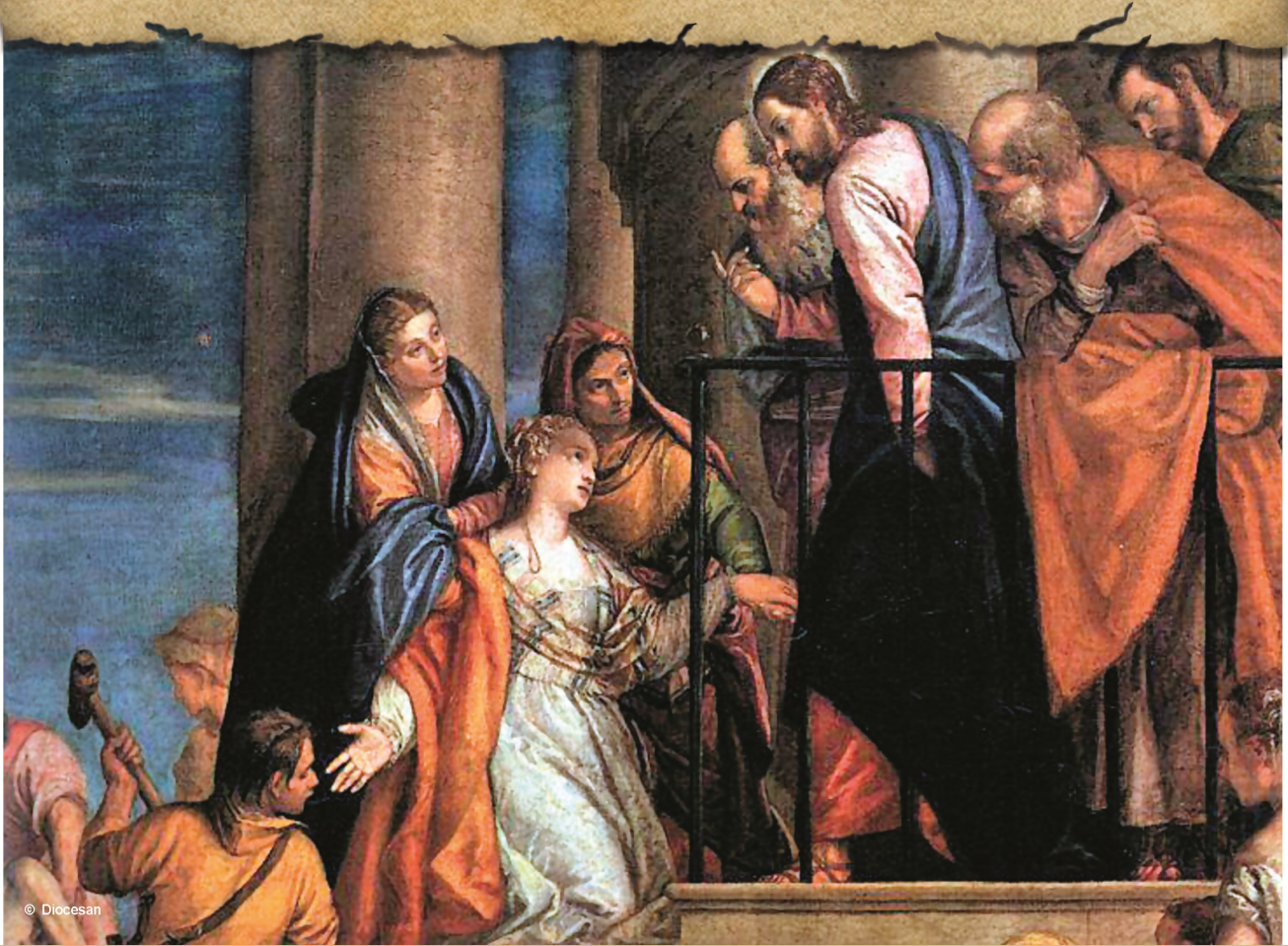

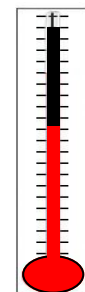

Vacation Bible School "Splash Canyon": packed with thrills and spills!

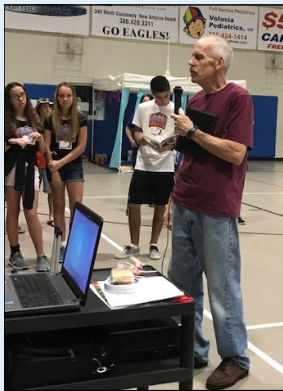

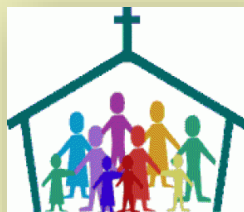
Training: Training is provided to help you get started in all the listed ministries.
