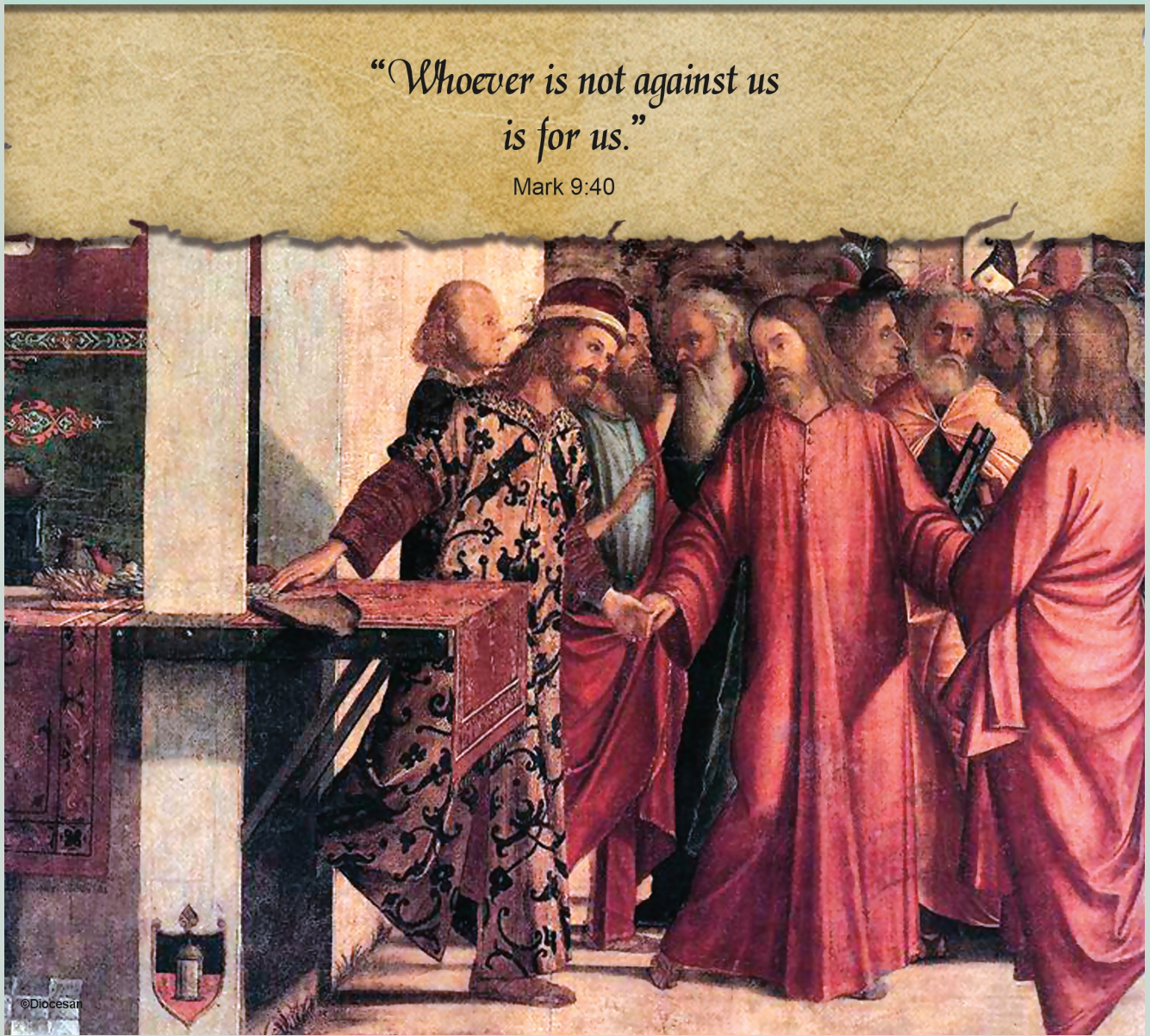

#### **Sister Diocese October 21, 2018**

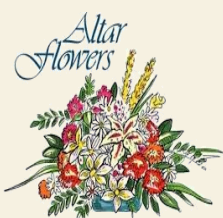

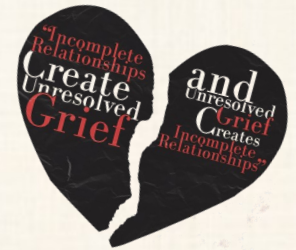
Saint Monica, patron of Christian parents,

All things are possible, through Christ, our Lord, Amen



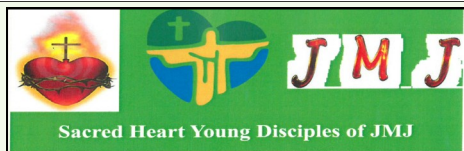
