

Happy New Year to all. Hoping this year will be a healthier and more prosperous year for all.

Just wanted to thank everyone for all the help and donations. Especially the boy scouts that collect donations and give them to Second Harvest for the holidays. Several of our volunteers were at the drop off site at Winn-Dixie in New

Smyrna Beach to help with the loading of food in boxes. With all our help second harvest donates to our pantry for our help. Ellen Graf from Saint Gerard's Choir helped with two considerately different fund raisers. The first was a the concert that was a combined effort by the Saint Gerard's, Sacred Heart, and Our



Lady of the Sea's Choirs which they donated \$1200. The second was the sale of Herbie the Hedge Hog which the donations was a combination of \$1500 and 49 Hedge Hogs that where donated back the SVdP that were given to the children and elderly. Without the parishioners and volunteers giving of their time and talents, we would not be able to

help our neighbors in need. Thank you all again.



How you help us help others: Several months ago we helped assist with a "neighbors" utilities. When that neighbor got back on their feet, they donated the amount that we helped them with, which was totally unexpected and which we took as and example of "Paying it Forward". One of our "neighbors" that receive groceries from us wanted



to help others by mowing lawns for handicapped veterans, so we were instrumental in connecting them. For the month of December our parishioners donated \$147.40(which does not include the fundraisers and group donations) and we were able to help 220 families to feed 564 people with groceries, 17 families with utilities, and 21 families that received prescriptions, gas, tent, propane, or bus passes.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are lay ministers who have been commissioned by the Bishop of Orlando to assist the priest in distributing Holy Communion at Mass. They serve at all Masses at Saint Gerard's Church – Saturdays at 4:30 pm, Sundays at 10:00 am, Wednesdays and First Friday at 9:00 am, Holy Days, Funeral Masses and, with special training, visits to the homebound.

Catholics in good standing must be recommended by the Pastor to the Diocese of Orlando. They are initially trained by the Diocese in a three hour class. These classes are held in various locations throughout the year. Once trained, the mandates are good for 5 years. After

the initial training, Extraordinary Ministers receive instruction on the procedures at Saint Gerard's Church.

Schedules are posted monthly. Ministers can indicate at what Mass they prefer to serve, and are asked to find a substitute if they are unable to serve on their scheduled day. They may be asked to arrive thirty minutes to an hour before Mass to help prepare for the Eucharistic celebration.

Baptized and confirmed Catholics are qualified to be Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Anyone interested in serving in this ministry can speak to any Eucharistic Minister, or **contact Jan Ford at 386-690-7623**


