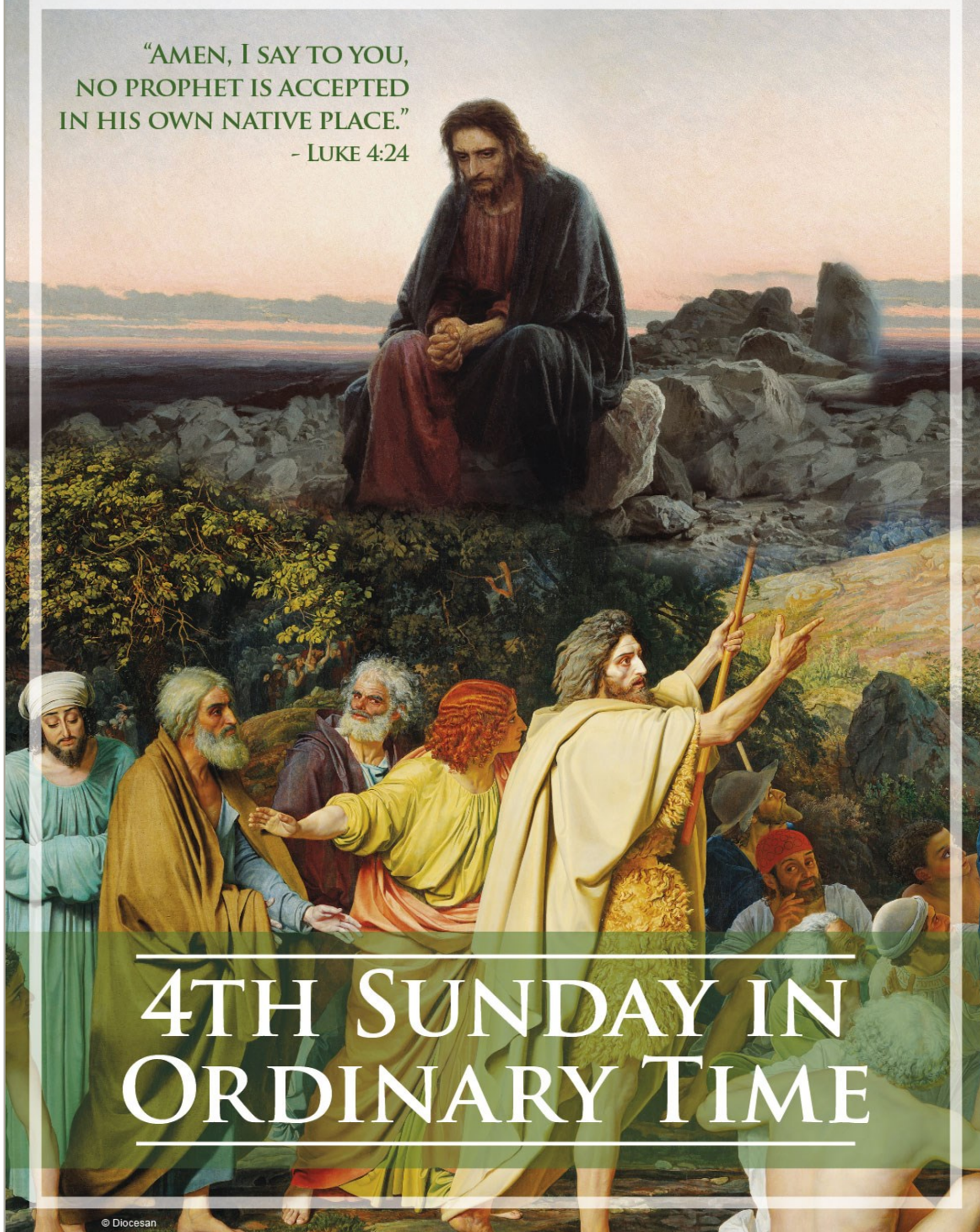

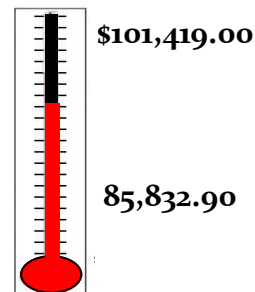

Faith in Leadership: Meet Sacred Heart School's Accreditation Team

Accreditation has been a big part of education and it is one way of ensuring and monitoring high quality standards of student learning and student success. School year 2018-2019 for Sacred Heart School demanded a strong attention on the accreditation process focused specifically on Catholic Identity, Curriculum, Academic Excellence, Early Learning, and Administration and Leadership. School plans were laid out in preparation for their seven-year accreditation visit. Being a Blue Ribbon School committed to maintaining excellence in Catholic education from PreK thru Grade 8, Sacred Heart School led by its principal Shelley Niswonger formed a Steering Committee that will oversee the accreditation process with key measures in mind: Catholic Identity and student learning and success. The Committee Chairpersons have their own teams that collected and collated evidences of learning and instruction and prepared reports for submission to the Accreditation Team comprising administrators from the State of Florida and the Diocese of Orlando. It was a tough undertaking!

The three-day visit on November 7-9, 2018 proved challenging but fruitful. The rigorous process eventually paid off. Strong and positive feedback of academic excellence nurtured by service and the Redemptorist charism of caring for the poor and the abandoned consistently revealed who and what Sacred Heart School is all about. The Accreditation Team said that "Sacred Heart School is very unique in the sense that parents, teachers, and students consistently mentioned the sense of family and support they have in the school." They also said that "the teachers and staff really like one another and it shows in their relationship each and every day." That said, the school thanked the parents, teachers and staff, and students for making this year's accreditation visit a success and a proof of what Catholic education is all about.

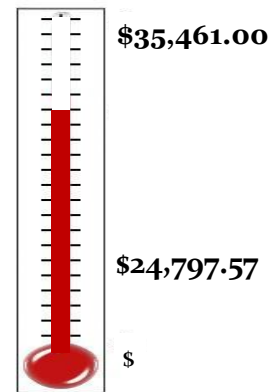
