Reflection

Jesus, through the Holy Spirit, unites us with the Father

How can we personally know the Father and his Son, our Lord Jesus Christ? Through the Holy Spirit, we proclaim our ancient faith in the saving death and resurrection of Jesus Christ until he comes again. Do you seek the wisdom that comes from above and do you eagerly listen to God's word and obey it?

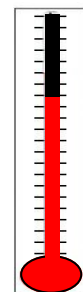

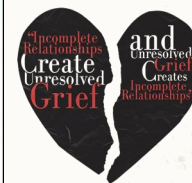

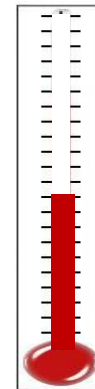
