



SACRAMENT INFORMATION

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Parents & Godparents are required to attend a Sacramental Preparation Class. Please call the Parish Office at 428-6426 to register.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Couples wanting to be married at Sacred Heart Parish must be registered and practicing members of this parish. An appointment must be made with one of the parish priests at least 6 months in advance of the wedding. The Diocese of Orlando requires a marriage preparation program for all couples.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Children who are 7 years or older, who have been baptized Roman Catholic, and who have participated in at least one full year of Religious Education during the previous year may be eligible to prepare for the Sacraments of Eucharist.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

At Sacred Heart Church the Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday afternoon from 3:00 to 3:45pm or by appointment - 428-6426.

ANOINTING of the SICK:

JULY 18TH—SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY REDEEMER

Every third Sunday of July, Redemptorists all over the

world celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Redeemer. Thus today, all churches, parishes and shrines all over the world under the care of Redemptorist has for its Sunday mass the solemnity of the Most Holy Redeemer in place of the 16th Sunday in ordinary



time. This is with special permission from Rome.

All Redemptorists have four letters after their names – **C.Ss.R.**

This stands for

Congregatio Sanctissimi Redemptoris.

This is the official Latin title given to its Religious Order. It can be translated into English as "Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer," more commonly called "Redemptorists."

On their coat of arms is written:

Copiosa Apud Eum Redemptio – With Him There Is Plentiful Redemption.

Indeed, the Feast of the Most Holy Redeemer is an expression of joy and gratitude for the great gift of the Redemption

Eternal rest grant unto them , O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them .

May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

July 18, 1992 - Rev. Paul Couming

Father Couming was born October 13, 1906 in Worcester, Massachusetts. He attended Holy Cross college and entered the Society of St. Edmund. He was ordained June 18, 1939 in the Society of St. Edmund and left to serve in missions in Alabama and New Jersey. He requested to serve in the Diocese of St. Augustine and arrived in 1944. He served in parishes in Miami, St. Petersburg, Tampa, Jacksonville, and Perry. He was incardinated in to the Diocese of St. Augustine in 1952. He became pastor of Blessed Trinity in Ocala in 1955-1962; returned to Tampa to serve there; he then served at St. Francis of Assisi in Apopka. Fr. Couming retired in 1972 and moved to New Port Richey.

He died July 18, 1992.




FAITH & PRAYER

My conversion to Catholicism

At age 5 I was enrolled in a Roman Catholic School in the West Indies, along with my 7 siblings. My parents were not Catholic My mom was Hindu, my Dad was Presbyterian but we practiced the Hindu Religion along with all my relatives.

I started to attend Weekly School Masses. My mom would not object because she prayed out loud all day long to Jesus. like my mom, I prayed also for God to help us in our daily struggles.





wake up @ 4.00 AM to have all my chores completed & be ready in my pretty Sunday dress for Jesus. I walked 2 miles with friends for 8.00 AM Mass. On Sundays afternoon we attended a protestant Sunday School Ministry in a village not far from our home. Since then I have wanted to become Catholic. This Church was Holy & Sacred for me but it took 50 years during which God was grooming me with my attending many various Protestant Churches where I served in a few ministries Stewardship Ministry, Choir, Ushering, Outreach & VP for Bible Study Groups. Going on Sunday Mornings & Wednesday evenings and Thursday evenings doing Home Visits, recruiting new members, some were Catholics who were happy with their Faith.

After 50 years, God put Bob in my Life with whom I attended my first Mass at Sacred Heart Catholic Church. Mass was Saturday Vigil weekend Mass. It was on December of 1999, the celebrant was Fr. Michael Dillion whom Bob & I followed behind his long procession of 10-12 down to the second pew on the right, the Church was full with over 600, having no parking space made me late. Most of the parishioners were my Deli Customers, which surprised me, that not one of them invited me to their Church.

Loving my R.C.I.A. weekly sessions, I could hardly wait for Thursdays to be with my 17 other participants. Years of Praying were unfolding as my hungering for every detail of Catholicism were being filled. Many thanks for my Religious Instructors namely Lloyd King(sadly missed Gary Mowers, Martha Grimes & Bunny Rock & of course our Spiritual Director, my dear friend Fr. John Barry CSSR (sadly missed) who lovingly groomed & nourished my questions & cravings to this faith. As a Protestant I did not understand the role of our Blessed Mother. I sought Fr. Barry's help to which he simply told me," if you want to have a relationship with Jesus, be sure you are a good friend of his Mother". I needed to learn more about her, amazingly she herself revealed her role to me via the movie, "Our Lady of Guadeloupe", since then praying the Holy Rosary daily is how my day starts. She is our Lord's advocate for his Church, another story to share in the future.

Our Lord Jesus & our Blessed Mother put people in my daily paths, the entire Parish were my new family along with Pastor Fr. Matt Dillion. God Bless all who have impacted my heart by adding flavor & Love with my Catholic Journey.




