Reflection

Jesus tells us that John the Baptist was more than a prophet (Luke 7:26). John was the voice of the Consoler who is coming (John 1:23; Isaiah 40:1-3). He completed the cycle of prophets begun by Elijah (Matthew 11:13-14). What the prophets had carefully searched for and angels longed to see, now came to completion as John made the way ready for the coming of the Messiah, God's Anointed Son, the Lord Jesus Christ. With John the Baptist, the Holy Spirit begins the restoration to the human race of the "divine likeness", prefiguring what would be achieved with and in the Lord Jesus.

John's baptism was for repentance - turning away from sin and taking on a new way of life according to God's word. Our baptism in Jesus Christ by water and the Spirit results in a new birth and entry into God's kingdom as His beloved sons and daughters (John 3:5). The Lord Jesus gives us the fire of His Spirit so that we may radiate the joy and truth of the Gospel to a world in desperate need of God's light and truth. His word has power to change and transform our lives that we may be lights pointing others to Christ. Like John the Baptist, we too are called to give testimony to the light and truth of Jesus Christ. Do you point others to Christ in the way you live, work, and speak?

Lord, let your light burn brightly in my heart that I may know the joy and freedom of your kingdom. Fill me with your Holy Spirit and empower me to witness the truth of your Gospel and to point others to Jesus Christ.

Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners

One day a young shepherd came into town with a large lump of yellow ore. Though its surface had traces of earth on it, when the experts cleaned and examined it they were flabbergasted. 'This is impossible!' they said. 'Everything on this earth is impure and contaminated in someway.'

'Do you mean its pure gold?' asked the shepherd.

'Yes. We can't find a trace of impurity in it. It's 24 carat. Just look at the way it shines.'

They showed him how to look at it, and he marveled at what he saw. 'Where did you find it?' they asked him.' I stumbled across it up in the mountains,' he replied.

'We can do anything we want with this,' they said. 'It has absolutely no need to be put through the refinery. If all ore was like this we'd be out of business.'

This week, on December 8th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. When we say that Mary was conceived without original sin, in a manner of speaking, we are saying that she was pure gold. Though made of the stuff of this earth, she had no impurities in her. From the beginning of her life she belonged totally to the kingdom of God. And all this she owed to a special act of God. In order that she might be a worthy mother for his Son God allowed her to enjoy in advance the benefits of Christ's redemption.

This does not mean that Mary's life was sunshine all the way. If anything, the opposite is nearer the truth. Her sinlessness made her more vulnerable. But, like pure gold, she was more pliable in the hands of God. She did not resist what his grace wanted to do in her and through her. And just as pure gold is an excellent conductor of electricity, Mary was an excellent conductor of God's light and love.

Since we come from the hand of God, we too have gold in us. But it is not yet of the 24 carat variety. We have impurities mixed in with it that dim its luster, and which make it more resistant to the hands of the Crafts-man, and a more imperfect conductor of His light and love.

But Jesus has made it possible for us to refine the gold in us. This process was begun at our Baptism, and will go on right throughout our lives. It will entail pain, sacrifice, and struggle. But Mary our Mother will help us. In her we see what we are called to be.




