

Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners

Today is Grandparents Day! So in celebration of this special day, I would like to share with you an essay that one third grader wrote about a special person in their life. He wrote about his grandma and this is what he

"A grandmother is a lady who has no children of her own, so she likes other people's boys and girls. Grandmas don't have anything to do except be there. If they take us for walks, they slow down past pretty leaves and caterpillars. They never say 'Hurry up.' Usually they are fat but not too fat to tie shoes. They wear glasses, and sometimes they can take their teeth out. They can answer questions like why dogs hate cats

and why God isn't married. They don't talk like visitors do which is hard to understand. When they read to us, they don't skip words or mind if it is the same story again. Everybody should try to have a grandma, especially if you don't have TV, because grandmas are the only grownups who always have time."

Grandparents: a few thoughts for you, too—

You have a unique chance an unbelievable opportunity, really to influence several generations... because the example you give your grandchildren will stay with them throughout their lives and have an impact on how they relate to their own children and grandchildren. Your special bond with your grandchildren lets you play so many wonderful roles! You can be a caretaker, storyteller, family historian, mentor, wizard, confidant, negotiator between child and parent, and even a model for your grandchild's own old age! And when a child has a strong emotional tie to a grandparent, they enjoy a kind of immunity—they don't have to perform for grandparents the way they must for their parents, peers and teachers. The love of grandparents comes with no strings attached.

Because of your special and unique relationship, you have an opportunity like no one else to lead your precious grandchildren to God. Grandparents have gone through many hardships and yet because they are faithful in their faith they have a great impact on children. Make sure your grandchildren learn the true faith. Teach them with your words, but even more by your examples. Teach them how to pray. Teach them to go to Mass every Sunday... and to go often to confession. Teach them to be proud to be Catholic and what that means. In other words, share with them the wisdom that earned you your grey hairs and is now leading you to holiness. That is why God entrusted grandchildren to you! Remember, you do not just serve the Lord while you are young, and then back off as you get older. You persist in faith and the labor of love all of your life

S.T.R.E.A.M. with Science

Mrs. Panagis' 6th grade science class were all hands on deck in preparing the next cycle of our aquaponics project. On its third year and in collaboration with Mrs. Walker, aquaponics is a self-sustainable garden system that uses tubes and pumps to circulate wastewater from fish to plants. The plants draw nutrients from fish waste and filter the water which is then circulated back to the fish.

This STREAM project helps in promoting care for God's creation, one of the seven themes of Catholic Social Teachings of the Church.


