

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Parents & Godparents are required to attend a Sacramental Preparation Class. Please call the Parish Office at 428-6426 to register.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Couples wanting to be married at Sacred Heart Parish must be registered and practicing members of this parish. An appointment must be made with one of the parish priests at least six months in advance of the wedding. The Diocese of Orlando requires a marriage preparation program for all couples.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Children who are seven years or older, who have been baptized Roman Catholic, and who have participated in at least one full year of Religious Education during the previous year may be eligible to prepare for the Sacraments of Eucharist.

At Sacred Heart Church the Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday from 3:00pm to 3:45pm or by appointment Please call the Parish Office at 428-6426.

EPIPHANY

Dear Parishioners


When we go to meet baby Jesus in the manger during the Christmas season, none of us want to go empty-handed! We remember this weekend how the three kings offered gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. Now you might think that those are gifts we can't offer today. But not so fast, perhaps we can at that!

Therefore I'd like to propose three simple gifts we can bring to the little King this New Year.

The gift of frankincense: the conversion of our heart.

Frankincense is the gift of priestly office. Christ the high priest became incarnate to save us. The first thing we can do to thank Him for this gift is to talk Him up on his offer. Recommit yourself to daily prayer by adding one small resolution to your

daily spiritual routine. It could be saying morning prayer, or praying the rosary or saying grace before meals if you don't already. The point is not to exhaust ourselves, but instead to grow in virtue and form better habits little by



Myrrh is the gift associated with burial and death. The most important thing we leave behind when we die is the legacy of our family and friends. Did we help them get to heaven, or were we a stumbling block for them? Let's recommit ourselves to renewing and improving our relationships with our friends and family, especially those relationships that are strained or broken. Now sometimes, patching up a relationship on our end alone is impossible. In those cases, let's commit ourselves to praying for that person. For most people, however, simply spending more time with them or staying in better touch will suffice!

The gift of gold: the recommitment to promoting the common good.

Gold is the gift associated with kingly office. All of us through baptism and confirmation are called to be missionaries in the world and to promote the common good of all. Let's pledge ourselves to give of our time and treasure (our gold!) to worthy causes. This could be joining a parish organization or ministry, praying outside an abortion clinic, serving at a soup kitchen or supporting St. Vincent DePaul. Most of all, let's recommit to fighting for a good cause we have despaired of in the past. We know with God all things are possible so giving up is not an option.

Christ came down to Earth to save us, to heal our broken relationships, and to sanctify the world. We can offer Him no better gifts than to become more serious about converting our hearts, more energetic in strengthening our relationships, and more passionate about making this world a better place. If we commit ourselves to doing these three simple things, we can go to meet the little King with our arms full of the gifts He desires most. Now that's a Happy Epiphany!

As we come to an end of the Christmas season this week with the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord tomorrow on Monday, I would like to thank all those who so freely and generously gave their gifts to Sacred Heart and St. Gerard. From those who contributed to our flower collection in memory of a loved one; to our talented musicians and choirs who brought a solemn celebration to our liturgies; those who ministered at our masses; those who decorated our church both inside and outside; and all those who silently worked behind the scenes. Like the kings, thank you for sharing your gifts with your parish.
