

#### Dear Parishioners

This week we are once again celebrating Catholic Schools Week. A time for us to thank God for our Catholic Schools, most especially our Parish Elementary School of Sacred Heart. 

#### **DENTAL / MENTAL**

It is known that gum health plays an important role in your overall health. Delta Dental quotes studies. Could gum disease be linked to Alzheimer's disease? Researchers think so. In one study

researchers analyzed brain tissue from Alzheimer's patients (Watts ert al) In 96% of cases they found bacteria P. gingivitis and a toxic enzyme it produces. That same bacteria increased dental plaque found in Alzheimer's patients. Researchers found that this bacteria can travel from the mouth to the brain and can destroy brain cells. This suggests a connection between bacteria found in gum disease and the development of Alzheimer's (Sparks, Stein et al) (Abbaya K.et al). More needs to be learned about oral health and Alzheimer's.

You help yourself fight gum disease by brushing twice a day, flossing daily and seeing your dentist regularly. Help a loved one who has dementia: check for dry mouth, cavities, broken teeth, and abscesses. Clean any dentures daily.
