

Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners

Today we celebrate and honor **St. Patrick**. St. Patrick was born in Wales in the year 387. When Patrick was 16 years old, he was walking along the beach when some pirates seized him. They took him to Ireland and sold him as a slave where he worked in the fields. One day, he heard God telling him to escape, and he ran down to the sea where he found a ship waiting to take him home. When he was grown up, he heard a voice calling on him to return to Ireland and to tell the people there about Christianity – which is what he did. You don't have to be Irish to admire Patrick; after all, St. Patrick himself was not Irish. His is a story of inspiration for anyone struggling through hard times, public or private, in a world with unknown terrors lurking around the corner. So raise a glass to the patron saint of Ireland, but remember the man and the saint behind the myth.

Two days later, March 19th, we celebrate the feast of **St. Joseph**. We shift from Irish to Italian! Italy has many saints that are celebrated during the entire year, especially in the south. Sicily's most important saint is San Giuseppe (St. Joseph). Many activities are scheduled, including the unique one called the St. Joseph's Table. This tradition is based on a story of a time when there was a severe drought in Sicily. No rain fell for an extended period of time, no crops would grow, and countless people died of famine. The people prayed to God for rain, and they also prayed to St. Joseph to intercede with God on their behalf. They promised that if God caused it to rain, they would have a special feast honoring God and St. Joseph. Their prayers were answered, and the famine came to an end. In gratitude, the people promised to make an annual offering of their most precious possession, food, in St. Joseph's honor. The tables which



are set to honor St. Joseph are filled with beautiful and elaborate foods, including meatless dishes, such as stuffed artichokes, cakes, pasta and fish, as well as breads in various shapes, cookies, pastries, cakes and other delicacies. The tradition of the bread that is blessed at the St. Joseph's table is kept in the home, so that the family will never starve.

Through the prayers, intercession and example of these two saints may this season of Lent be a time for us to be transformed and transfigured more closely into the likeness of Christ.

<u>Just a little reminder</u>, next week is <u>Palm Sunday</u>. Besides the distribution of Palms, we will have the proclamation of the Passion of Jesus. Both of these are an integral part of what makes next week such a special and solemn entrance into Holy Week. It also tends to extend Mass a little longer than usual as well. So a little extra patience and kindness both in Church and in the parking lot would be a wonderful example and witness! There will also be a Palm Sunday outdoor procession at the 10:30am Mass, beginning in front of the Parish Hall. If you would like to participate, please gather there. Or you are welcome to remain in Church.

There will also be a procession at St. Gerard at the 10am Mass that Sunday as well! Wave them palms!

Also, I am sure many of you have received an Easter Flower envelope in the mail. As we did at Advent, we will do again for Easter. All the donations we receive will go toward helping defray the cost of the beautiful Easter flowers that will adorn our altars at Easter. You are invited on this envelope to write the names of loved ones you would like to be remembered in prayer. These envelopes will remain on our altar throughout the Easter season. Thank You!



What's Happening & News Around the Parish




