

Dear Parishioners

One day, St. Francis and some monks were walking around the Italian countryside when he saw a large flock of birds hanging out in the branches of a tree. Suddenly, he was overcome by the Holy Spirit and began to preach a sermon to these birds. He told them all about how much God loved them. "My sweet little sisters, birds of the sky," Francis said, "You are bound to heaven, to God, your Creator. In every beat of your wings and every note of your songs, praise Him. He has given you the greatest of gifts, the freedom of the air. "You neither sow, nor reap, yet God provides for you the most delicious food; rivers and lakes to quench your thirst, mountains and valleys for your home, tall trees to build your nests and the

most beautiful clothing: a change of feathers with every season."

I thought of that little story because, on April 22nd, we celebrated Earth Day! And I didn't want to let that day pass without recognition. Earth day is celebrated each year to help remind us of God's love for all of creation – not only humanity, but also the birds and fish and ferocious lions, every animal and insect and other creeping creatures, even them little lizards all over Florida! 
