

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Parents & Godparents are required to attend a Sacramental Preparation Class. Please call the Parish Office at 428-6426 to register.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Couples wanting to be married at Sacred Heart Parish must be registered and practicing members of this Parish. An appointment must be made with one of the Parish priests at least six months in advance of the wedding. The Diocese of Orlando requires a marriage preparation program for all couples.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Children who are seven years or older, who have been baptized Roman Catholic, and who have participated in at least one full year of religious education during the previous year may be eligible to prepare for the Sacraments of Eucharist.

Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners

About the time that Columbus sailed the Santa Maria to the shores of the Americas, another ship took the image of Our Mother of Perpetual Help to the shores of Europe. Who painted it, or when, we do not know. It was venerated on the isle of Crete, and from Crete it sailed to Rome. There a private family held the image until the Blessed Mother appeared in a vision to the little girl of the household, saying she wished her picture to be placed in a church "between my beloved Church of St. Mary Major and that of my beloved son, St. John of Lateran."

On March 27, 1499, the picture was exposed for veneration in the Church of St. Matthew where it remained for three centuries, drawing pilgrims from all parts of the world. In 1798 the church was demolished, but the picture was preserved by the Augustinian Fathers who had been in charge

of St. Matthew's and who took the icon with them to their new monastery in another part of Rome.

The very last member of their order to profess his vows in Old St. Matthew's was Brother Augustine Orsetti. In his new home he had a frequent visitor, a youth named Michael Marchi, who later became a Redemptorist priest. The Redemptorists came to Rome in 1855 and built a church in honor of our founder, St. Alphonsus Maria de Liguori, on the site of the ancient St. Matthew's. The old brother had often spoken to young Michael about the Madonna in the monastery chapel saying, "Don't forget now -mind me well -the picture in our chapel is the one that was venerated in Old St. Matthew's. It was indeed a miraculous picture."

The Redemptorists then petitioned Pope Pius IX to have the image returned to the site indicated by Our Lady, the site where our church now stands. In granting the request, the pope said: "It is our will that this picture of the Blessed Virgin be returned to the church between St. Mary Major and St. John Lateran." At the same time, he commanded the Redemptorists to "make her known" all over the world. This year marks the 158th year of that charge given to the Redemptorists.

On April 26, 1866, the icon was carried in a solemn procession to the Church of St. Alphonsus, one of Mary's greatest lovers and defenders. Today the original painting is displayed in Rome while millions of replicas bring her and her Perpetual Help to people everywhere. We celebrate the Feast of Our Mother of Perpetual Help this week on June 27th.

We also celebrate soon after two of our Redemptorist Blesseds, Blessed Nicholas Charnetsky (June 28)

and Blessed Gennaro Sarnelli (June 30). Through the intercession of this special trio of holiness, may more men hear and answer the call to Redemptorist priesthood and religious life.






