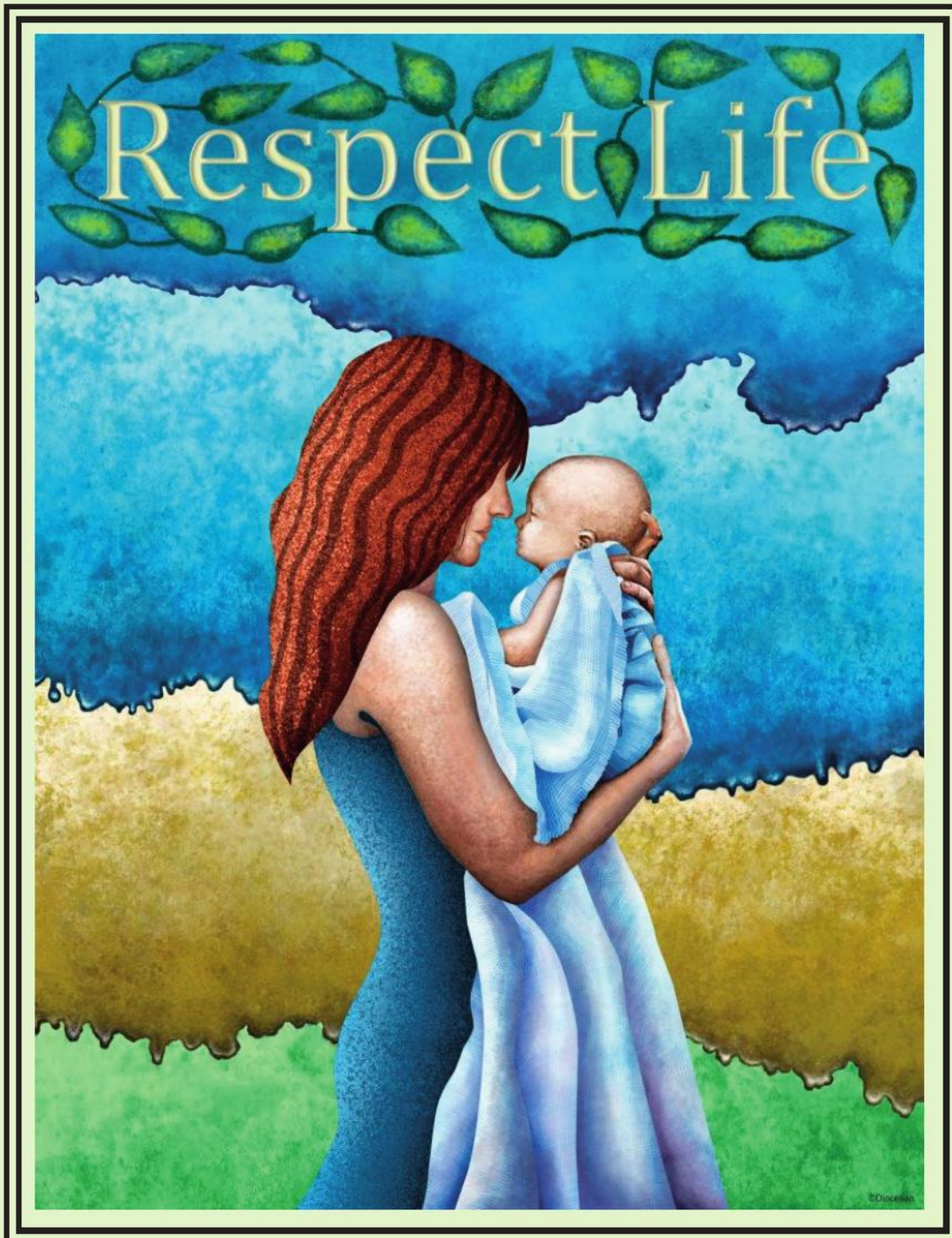

Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners

During this month of October, not only do we celebrate **Respect Life**, but rightly so, we also honor our Blessed Mother and the prayer of her rosary. Tomorrow, Tues, October 7th, we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. In light of this, I would like to share the following story and poem. This is **not my story** but one that was shared with me that I share now with you.

Although this is really my mother's story, I am honored to tell it in her memory. I learned about it at my mother's funeral, when a man came up to me, offered his sympathy, and proceeded to tell me this story. He said that when he was a young man, he became involved with a woman who was not his wife. He was having dinner with this woman in a restaurant one evening when my mother and father entered. They pre-tended not to recognize one another, but the next day the man received a call from my mother inviting him to her home for a piece of pie. The man said that he went because no one ever refused my mother's pie, but he also realized that the invitation was really an order. He arrived at the designated time, enjoyed his piece of pie, and then my mother told him that she had seen him in the restaurant with this other woman. He denied it, but no matter how often or how vehemently he denied it, my mother would not back down. Finally she said, "Do you remember when you were out of work for several months, and I fed you and your family for all of that time?" He said that he did remember. My mother continued, "I want to be repaid." The man immediately reached into his pocket to get his wallet, but my mother said, "No, I don't want any money. I want a favor." The man agreed to do anything that he could to repay her. My mother reached into a drawer and took out a rosary. She placed it into his hand and told him to go to Mass every day for a week and say the rosary every day either before or after Mass. She told him to say the prayer attached to each bead and think of something good about his wife, his children, or their life together. Then she told him: "If at the end of the week you think this woman is better for you than your wife, just put the rosary in my mailbox, and I will never speak of this again, to either you or your wife. However, if you decide to go back to your wife, please keep the rosary with my prayers and blessing." At this point in telling me his story, the man opened his hand and said, "This is the rosary your mother gave me so many years ago. My wife and I have said it every day since then."

Walk, Pray and Count

*Every morning, when I walk
With my precious Lord, I talk.
I thank him for His patient love,
For His gifts and blessings from above.*

*I thank Him for nature around me I see,
And often—I pray the rosary.
To pray to His mother is a joy and a gift,
And as I honor her my own spirits I lift.*

*If I've forgotten to bring my beads,
I've found that's quite okay.
Cause God has helped me even in this
As I count my prayers a different way.*

*God gave me ten fingers on which to count.
As I say each ten Hail Mary's—prayers and fingers—the
same amount!*

*So for each ten Hail Mary's, as I maintain my pace,
My fingers tuck in—so to keep my place.
When all ten are tucked in—no more to bend,
Comes the Glory Be and World without End.*

*The five decades move swiftly,
Soon all the prayers have been prayed.
My walk has gone quickly,
A spiritual foundation for my day has been laid.*

*I thank our Blessed Mother for this gift to me,
A warm wonderful prayer—her rosary.
I thank God for the rosary and my finger count way to say it,
Cause even when I'm forgetful—I can still pray it.*

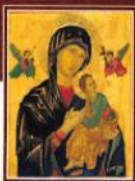
Day Trip to St. Augustine

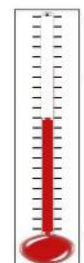
