

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Parents & Godparents are required to attend a Sacramental Preparation Class. Please call the Parish Office at 428-6426 to register.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Couples wanting to be married at Sacred Heart Parish must be registered and practicing members of this parish. An appointment must be made with one of the parish priests at least six months in advance of the wedding. The Diocese of Orlando requires a marriage preparation program for all couples.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Children who are seven years or older, who have been baptized Roman Catholic, and who have participated in at least one full year of religious education during the previous year may be eligible to prepare for the Sacraments of Eucharist.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

At Sacred Heart Church the Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday from 3:00pm to 3:45pm or by appointment. Please call the Parish Office at 428-6426.

As you SHOULD know by now, NEXT WEEKEND is our Raise the Roof 2 event! We all had such a good time last year, I sincerely hope you can come again and join in on the fun, meet new and old friends and parishioners, while at the same time supporting Sacred Heart and St. Gerard!

Now you might be wondering why again if we already have a new roof on our Father Burke Hall? You are right...but the needs and maintenance on all our buildings continues! So this major parish fundraiser will help to build up our newly established "Maintenance Fund Account".

This will help provide the necessary funds needed so we can address the ongoing future issues and be good stewards of the beautiful buildings entrusted to our care and that are used so much for all our ministries! Just this year alone thus far we have had to address and repair the following:

New air conditioning unit for the Church Chapel.

New electric service panel for the Social Hall.

New air conditioning unit for the Social Hall east end, near the entrance.

New air conditioner for the Social Hall kitchen.

Replaced the handicap ramp at Fr. Burke Hall.

All miscellaneous maintenance repairs on all buildings including the school.

All lawn and yard maintenance, trimming, mowing and sprinklers.

After Hurricane Milton, we had to address the air condition unit at St. Gerard. A leak on the flat part of Sacred Heart Church forces us to address that issue earlier than planned as well.

Shortly, I will be putting here in the bulletin a summarized financial report of the parish so you can see some financial numbers and their use.

Not only is this Raise the Roof 2 but this is also a TWO day Salute to our Vets celebration event as well! Day 1, the first and opening to the weekend is a dinner dance on Saturday, November 9th.
