

### Pastor's Corner



### Dear Parishioners,

As we continue in the season of Advent, we celebrate not one, but two feasts of our Blessed Mother, Sunday, Dec. 8 th(Dec. 9<sup>th</sup> this year). We celebrate the Immaculate Conception – And this Thursday, December 12th, is the feast of <u>Our Lady of Guadalupe</u>, patroness of the Americas, unborn children, and the New Evangelization. Our Lady of Guadalupe is unlike any other apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary. First, it is the only apparition where Our Lady left a miraculous image of herself unmade by human hands. Second, it is the only universally venerated Madonna and Child image where Our Lady appears

pregnant instead of holding the Infant Jesus. There is a such a fascinating story surrounding the image itself and its highly unusual properties.

The Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to St. Juan Diego, who was canonized in 2002 by Pope John Paul II (and whose feast we celebrated just a few days ago on Dec. 9th) in the 16th century in present day Mexico City, Mexico. Juan Diego saw an apparition of the Blessed Virgin on the Hill of Tepeyac on December 9, 1531, which happened to be the feast day of the Immaculate Conception in that time. Our Lady requested that a church be built on that site, which Juan Diego dutifully relayed to the bishop. After a request by the bishop to prove her identity, Our Lady asked Juan Diego to gather roses that were growing on the hill (which were neither native to the area nor in season) and take them to the bishop. Juan Diego obeyed and placed the roses in his tilma (or cloak) to carry back to the bishop as evidence of Our Lady's appearance. Upon opening the tilma to reveal the miraculous roses to the bishop, there was something even more miraculous present in the tilma—a striking image of the Blessed Virgin Mary. A church was built at Our Lady's request on the Hill of Tepeyac to mark the apparition site, and today it is the most visited Catholic pilgrimage shrine in the world. Venerated in this cathedral is the original tilma of St. Juan Diego, which still displays the miraculous Our Lady of Guadalupe image.

The voice of the Virgin of Guadalupe called Juan Diego. Juan Diego was humble, and he heard her voice. He was obedient and faithful, and he obeyed. Like Juan Diego, the voice of the Virgin calls us and we want to hear her voice. We want to hear the voice of the Virgin because she will tell us about the Lord Jesus, whose coming is so near. We want to hear her voice because we want to know the Lord Jesus. We want to know Him, because the prophets promised Him. We want to know Him because in Him alone we will find salvation. In Him alone we will know the love that the Father has for us. In Him alone, our prayers and our lives will be accepted in the presence of the Father. If we listen to the voice of the Virgin, she will lead us to the Kingdom of her Son.

The image of our Lady of Guadalupe hangs in the vestibule of Sacred Heart church. Take the time this week to go to her during this time of waiting and expectation that we call Advent. Go to her with your prayers and intentions and ask her most powerful intercession. May the Immaculate Conception of our Blessed Mother, and Our Lady of Guadalupe, patroness of the Americas, pray for us, Amen. Viva la Virgen de Guadalupe!



their commitment to their Faith, Family and Community Service. These Sisters are always giving back especially to St. Gerard's. Thank you Freida and Lynn GOD BLESS.




