

Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners.

Worried about the little country church's tough financial straits, its pastor asked the parishioners to dig deep into their pockets. "Dig deep," he said over and over as the collection plate was passed down the pews. "Dig deep!" At the end of the service, a young boy tugged on the pastor's robe. "Did you get the money you needed for the church?" The reverend shook his head sadly. "I'm afraid we didn't dig deep enough today, young man." "I know just how you feel, Father. I've been in the back yard digging to China all summer, and I'm still not there either."

One of the requirements of a pastor, is to give the parish a financial report. So since Christmas is "officially and liturgically" over, and we are now in "Ordinary Time" of the church year, what is more ordinary than money! So I thought this might be a good time to give you this report. I thought this would be a good time also, because with more people back from up north or from vacations, I wanted to provide a brief parish financial summary for you. You will find this report on the insert in this bulletin.

Everything we are able to do in our parish is achieved from the generous support of you which is truly appreciated. Your contributions through weekly budget envelopes and fundraising events during the year provide not only the ability to meet our operating expenses but also our capital repair needs. Unfortunately, as you all have seen in your own households, costs continue to increase within the parishes for many items like insurance, utilities and health care. We have attempted to reduce these cost increases to the best of our ability with the help of the Diocese. The following will briefly describe our financial results for our financial year that ended on June 30, 2024. As you will see, our parish is strong and in good financial foundation.

In addition to the annual operating budget, there are capital repair items that are needed to maintain our buildings and grounds. In Fiscal Year 2024 there were three major air conditioning units that were no longer serviceable and needed to be replaced. The Father Burke Memorial Hall also needed a roof replacement which was completed as well. The parish is working on a Five Year Capital plan to establish the future capital needs of the parish along with a funding plan to meet these needs in the future. Your continued support of our fundraising for these needs is deeply appreciated.

My special thanks to Jerry Williams and our parish finance council, to our faithful parishioners who count the collection each and every week, and to Ella Copeland who works with the Diocese for our parish financial accounts, deposits and expenses.

Lastly, and most importantly, my thanks and gratitude to you, the parishioners of Sacred Heart and St. Gerard. Thank you for your support, generosity and love of our parish!
