


#### **BLACK and INDIAN MISSIONS**

## Pastor's Corner



#### Dear Parishioners

During the Mass of canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000, the year of the Great Jubilee, Pope John Paul II, who along with Pope John XXIII is raised to sainthood today, proclaimed: "It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God on this **Second Sunday of Easter**, which from now on throughout the Church, will be called **Divine Mercy Sunday**."

So, just who is St. Faustina? Saint Faustina was born Helena Kowalska in a small village west of Lodz, Poland on August 25, 1905. She was the third of ten children. When she was almost twenty, she entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, whose members devote themselves to the care and education of troubled young women. The following year she

received her religious habit and was given the name Sister Maria Faustina, to which she added, "of the Most Blessed Sacrament", as was permitted by her congregation's custom. In the 1930's, Sister Faustina received from the Lord a message of mercy that she was told to spread throughout the world. She was asked to become the apostle and secretary of God's mercy, a model of how to be merciful to others, and an instrument for reemphasizing God's plan of mercy for the world. It was not a glamorous prospect.

Her entire life, in imitation of Christ's, was to be a sacrifice - a life lived for others. She wrote and suffered in secret, with only her spiritual director and some of her superiors aware that anything special was taking place in her life. After her death from tuberculosis in 1938, even her closest associates were amazed as they began to discover what great sufferings and deep mystical experiences had been given to this Sister of theirs, who had always been so cheerful and humble. She had taken deeply into her heart, God's gospel command to "be merciful even as your heavenly Father is merciful" as well as her confessor's directive that she should act in such a way that everyone who came in contact with her would go away joyful. The message of mercy that Sister Faustina received is now being spread throughout the world; her diary, Divine Mercy in my Soul, has become the handbook for devotion to the Divine Mercy. Her feast day is celebrated on October 5<sup>th</sup>.

Lastly, just a reminder...Tuesday, Sunday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>, we celebrate Earth Day. I didn't want that day pass without reminding us all of its significance, and its importance to our earth and our environment. That is the reason and purpose of Earth Day. We only have one earth, so we need to take care of her. That is what Senator Gaylord Nelson of Wisconsin believed. He was disturbed that an issue as important as our environment was not addressed in politics or by the media, so he created the first Earth Day, on April 22, 1970. This day has been celebrated over 50 years now! The theme for Earth Day 2025 is "Our Power, Our Planet," focusing on the importance of renewable energy and aiming to triple global clean energy generation by 2030. There's just this one planet of ours, and it's on all of us to safeguard a future with a livable climate, healthy communities and thriving nature—during Earth Month, on Earth Day and every day. Let's put our heads, hands and hearts together and take action to preserve and protect the natural world for generations to come. We thank God for entrusting this beautiful creation of His – to US!

## April 27, 2025 - 1st teenage of the millennial generation becomes a Saint!

**Carlo Acutis** was born on May 3, 1991, in London to a wealthy Italian family, and grew up in Milan.



His precocious faith journey took off after he received First
Communion at the young age of 7, and he regularly attended daily Mass, prayed the rosary and participated in eucharistic adoration. While he enjoyed regular pastimes for his age-hiking, video games, and joking around with friends – he also taught catechism in a local

parish and did outreach to the homeless.
Acutis used his computer savvy to create an online exhibit about more than 100 eucharistic miracles recognized by the church over many centuries, focused on the real presence of Christ that Catholics believe is in the consecrated bread and wine.
Several miracles have been attributed to people praying for his intercession which has led the path to his sainthood.

Acutis' canonization Mass will be Sunday, April 27th, at 10:30 a.m. in front of the Vatican's St. Peter Basilica, in conjunction with the celebration of the jubilee for teens.
