



To help us celebrate this special day, we will again have our parish picnic after the 10:30am Mass here at Sacred Heart!

There will be games for kids to play – organized by Sacred Heart School.

Food – hamburgers and hot dogs on the grill prepared by the chefs of the Knights of Columbus and water will be available also of course!




