SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Parents & Godparents are required to attend a Sacramental Preparation Class. Please call the Parish Office at 428-6426 to register.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Couples wanting to be married at Sacred Heart Parish must be registered and practicing members of this parish. An appointment must be made with one of the parish priests at least six months in advance of the wedding. The Diocese of Orlando requires a marriage preparation program for all couples.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Children who are seven years or older, who have been baptized Roman Catholic, and who have participated in at least one full year of Religious Education during the previous year may be eligible to prepare for the Sacraments of Eucharist.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

At Sacred Heart Church the Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday afternoon from 3-3:45pm or by appointment-428-6426.

Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners,

There was a young boy riding on his new bike outside a Church. The priest saw him and told him to come into the Church, and the boy said, "But they'll steal my bike. It's new, and expensive too."

The priest explained how the Holy Spirit would take care of it, and he shouldn't bother about it at all. So they went inside. The priest showed the boy how to make the sign of the cross and told the boy to repeat it.

"In the name of the Father, and of the Son. Amen," said the boy.

The priest said, "Hey! What about the Holy Spirit?" The boy replied, "Oh! It's outside taking care of my bike!"

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity. And, yes, the Trinity is in fact a mystery that cannot be fully explained or understood, only believed. This feast of the Most Holy Trinity is also a celebration of what I like to call, an out-pouring of **outrageous grace**. Outrageous grace isn't a favor you can achieve by being good; it's the gift you receive by being God's. Outrageous grace is a one-way love that calls you into the kingdom, not because you've been good, but because God has chosen you and made you his own. And now he is chasing you to the ends of the earth to keep you as his child, and nothing in Heaven or Hell can ever stop him...

But here's what's amazing about God's outrageous grace: This isn't merely what God the Father would do; it's what he did do. God could have chosen to save anyone, everyone, or no one from Adam's fallen race. But what God did was to choose a multi-hued multitude of "someones," and — if you are a believer in Jesus Christ — one of those "someones" was you. God in His Son Jesus Christ and in the power and presence of the Holy Spirit, has declared over you, "I could have chosen anyone in the whole world as my child, and I chose you. No matter what you say or do, neither My love nor My choice will ever change." That's grace that is truly amazing. That's the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity. That's the spirit of Father's Day!

On this weekend, we also celebrate Father's Day. Although these two celebrations rarely occur on the same day, there is an intimate connection between them. On the one hand, Father's Day celebrates the blessing of fatherhood, that gift whereby a man becomes responsible for another human life. On the other hand, the Feast of the Holy Trinity celebrates the mystery of God's fatherhood. For, on this day we proclaim that the one God is a trinity of persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Although we call God "Father," God is neither male nor female. God is mysterious and beyond our human understanding. We address God as "Father" because the Son of God has taught us to call his Father "our Father." We call God "Father" through the power of the Holy Spirit who enables us to call God "our Father." So what does the fatherhood of God teach us about what it means to be a human father?

The Fatherhood of God teaches us three things. First, a strong father is kind and merciful. Second, a good father brings peace and love to his family. Third, a wise father never condemns and rarely judges. I congratulate all of the men of our parish today: you who are biological fathers and you who are fathers to the young in so many other ways. For when you exercise your fatherhood in mercy, love, and restraint, you show us what it means to call God "Our Father."
