

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Parents & Godparents are required to attend a Sacramental Preparation Class. Please call the Parish Office at 428-6426 to register.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Couples wanting to be married at Sacred Heart Parish must be registered and practicing members of this parish. An appointment must be made with one of the parish priests at least six months in advance of the wedding. The Diocese of Orlando requires a marriage preparation program for all couples.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Children who are seven years or older, who have been baptized Roman Catholic, and who have participated in at least one full year of Religious Education during the previous year may be eligible to prepare for the Sacraments of Eucharist.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

At Sacred Heart Church the Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday afternoon from 3-3:45pm or by appointment-428-6426.

ANOINTING of the SICK:

If you have a loved one who would like to receive the Anointing of the Sick please call the Parish Office, 428-6426.

COMMUNION for Shut-Ins:

Call the Parish Office- 428-6426 to arrange a Friday visit.

MINISTRY to the SICK and Homebound:

If there is anyone at home who cannot get to Mass to celebrate the Sacraments because of illness or age, please call the Parish Office, 428-6426





Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners

The other day, on Friday, the Church celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. I didn't want such an important day to pass without recognition and sharing a few words.

There's a story told of a young boy who, along with his older siblings, was visiting his grandmother. The older siblings were telling the grandmother about their all-school Mass from the previous week, where they had celebrated the Sacred Heart of Jesus. They were keen to share with their grandmother what they had learned about Jesus and His love for them. The more they conversed with her, however, the more upset


the youngest one became, until he finally burst into tears. His grandmother asked him what was wrong, and he answered, "Nana, I looked really carefully at the cross in Church, and I paid real close attention during Mass, but I just couldn't see Jesus' secret heart!"

Bless him, for didn't this young one in his mishearing of the solemnity, and the object of devotion, identify for us our own occasions of missing the point? For there is nothing secret about Jesus' heart, or His profound, boundless love for us. There it is, laid bare upon that cross. We speak of people "wearing their heart on their sleeve," and here is our redeemer wearing his heart in the crown of thorns on His head, and in the stripes of the scourge and the wood of the cross on His back. No, there is nothing secret, and everything sacred, about Jesus' heart.

What the young boy misunderstood, and what the Church aims to do with this devotion, is to recognize "the fact that [Christ's] Heart, more than all the other members of His body, is the natural sign and symbol of His boundless love for the human race. 'There is in the Sacred Heart,' as Our predecessor of immortal memory, as a previous, not current Pope Leo but Leo XIII, pointed out, 'the symbol and express image of the infinite love of Jesus Christ which moves us to love in return'.

What an honor and blessing that our parish bears the name, spirit and holiness of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We give thanks to God for the countless parishioners, who through our 100 years as a parish, have born witness to that love of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in love and service of others. Through the intercession and example of Saints Peter and Paul whom the Church honors this weekend, may we like them believe and share of love of Jesus Christ and His Sacred Heart as they did. Saint Peter and Saint Paul, pray for us!

It is no secret that God loves us. Let there be no secret that we love Him.


Pastors Pun: Why is there no knock-knock joke about America? **Because freedom rings.**




twisted and turned faster than they could imagine. Next, they explored amazing themed worlds, where they could interact with their favorite characters and embark on thrilling adventures.




