





#### Pastor's Corner



#### Dear Parishioners

This week, on August 1<sup>st</sup> we celebrate the Feast of St. Alphonsus, founder of the Redemptorists. St. Alphonsus also stands near our Our Mother of Perpetual Help on our altar in the sanctuary.

St. Alphonsus Liguori was born in 1696 near Naples, Italy, into a noble and devout family. A brilliant student, he earned a doctorate in law by the age of 16 and began a successful career as a lawyer. However, after a profound spiritual experience, Alphonsus felt called to the priesthood and left his legal career behind.

Ordained in 1726, Alphonsus dedicated himself to preaching and ministering to the poor and marginalized. He founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, known as the Redemptorists, in 1732. The Redemptorists focused on missionary work, especially in rural and neglected areas, spreading the Gospel and providing spiritual and material support to those in need.

Alphonsus was a prolific writer producing numerous theological works, devotional writings, and hymns. His most famous work, "The Glories of Mary," reflects his deep Marian devotion. He also wrote extensively on moral theology,

emphasizing the importance of a balanced and compassionate approach to ethical issues. St. Alphonsus was known for his gentle and pastoral approach to moral teaching, advocating for understanding and mercy rather than strictness and severity. He was declared a Doctor of the Church in 1871 for his significant contributions to theology and spirituality.

Although he was sickly for much of his life, Alphonsus' final years were marked by very serious and debilitating physical ailments, especially arthritis, which caused him great pain and confined him to a wheelchair. He also was plagued with spiritual afflictions, scrupulously fearing he hadn't done enough to serve the God he loved so much. To help him through these times, his confreres gathered with him to pray. They read to him from his own writings about the glory of Mary and how, as heaven's queen, she welcomed all her true and faithful servants at the hour of their death.

Early in the evening on July 31, 1787, Alphonsus made one final request. "Give me my lady," he whispered. They placed a picture of Mary in his hands. He spent the night praying with the Blessed Mother. The next day at the stroke of the noon Angelus, Alphonsus died at the age of 91.

St. Alphonsus was canonized in 1839 and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1871. He was recognized as a patron of confessors and moral theologians in 1950.

Pope St. John Paul II described Alphonsus as "a close friend of the people . . . a missionary who went in search of the most abandoned souls . . . a founder who wanted a group which would make a radical option in favor of the lowly . . . a Bishop whose house was open to all . . . a writer who focused on what would be of benefit to people."

#### Saint Alphonsus Ligouri Fun Facts

- + Alphonsus became very popular because of his plain and simple preaching.
- + Graduated with doctorates in civil and canon law at age 16.
- + He learned to ride and fence but was never a good shot because of poor evesight.
- + Gifted musician, composer and poet.
- + Was noted for suspending priests who celebrated Mass in less than 15 minutes.
- + Sold his episcopal ring to give money to the poor.
- + Patron Saint of Rheumatoid Arthritis.
- + Suffered from scruples much of his adult life and felt guilty about the most minor issues relating to sin.
- + One of 37 Doctors of the Catholic Church recognized for their significant contribution to theology and Doctrine.
