SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Parents & Godparents are required to attend a Sacramental Preparation Class. Please call the Parish Office at 428-6426 to register.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Couples wanting to be married at Sacred Heart Parish must be registered and practicing members of this parish. An appointment must be made with one of the parish priests at least six months in advance of the wedding. The Diocese of Orlando requires a marriage preparation program for all couples.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Children who are seven years or older, who have been baptized Roman Catholic, and who have participated in at least one full year of Religious Education during the previous year may be eligible to prepare for the Sacraments of Eucharist.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

At Sacred Heart Church the Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday afternoon from 3-3:45pm or by appointment-428-6426.

ANOINTING of the SICK:

Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners

This Thursday we celebrate the feast day of the great St. Augustine. A Bishop and Doctor of the Church, noted for the writing of his Confessions, and founder of the Augustinians.

But before we celebrate him, we first celebrate his mother, St. Monica, the day before on Wednesday. She is recognized as the patron saint of mothers, wives, difficult marriages, and conversions. Here is why...

St. Monica is one of the most powerful examples of the strength of a mother's love and the incredible impact of persistent prayer. Her story reminds us that even when everything seems hopeless, God hears the prayers we offer with faith and perseverance.

Born in the fourth century in North Africa, Monica was a devout Christian married to a pagan man who had a violent temper. Her husband didn't share her faith, and to make things harder, their son, Augustine, grew up to be rebellious and deeply immersed in a sinful lifestyle.

Augustine rejected Christianity, pursued a life of pleasure and ambition, and even joined a heretical sect known as the Manicheans. For most people, this would have been a reason to despair. But Monica did not give up. She spent over 17 years fervently praying for her son's conversion. Through tears, fasting, and constant prayer, she brought her heartbreak before God, trusting that in His perfect time, He would act. Monica's prayers were not immediately answered. In fact, things seemed to get worse before they got better. Augustine moved away to Rome and then Milan, seemingly farther from God than ever. Yet Monica followed him, never losing hope. She believed that no soul was beyond the reach of God's mercy.

In Milan, Augustine met the great bishop and saint Ambrose, who helped him see the beauty of the Catholic faith. After years of struggle, Augustine finally surrendered to God. He was baptized at the age of 31 by St. Ambrose, and he would go on to become one of the greatest theologians and saints in the history of the Church — St. Augustine of Hippo. Monica lived just long enough to see the fruit of her prayers. Shortly before her death, she told Augustine, "There was indeed one thing for which I wished to tarry a little in this life, and that was that I should see you a Catholic Christian before I die. My God has granted me this in abundance." St. Monica's story is a powerful reminder that persistent, faithful prayer can move mountains. Even when we don't see immediate results, God is always working behind the scenes. Our job is to trust, to pray, and to never lose hope.

St. Monica and St. Augustine, pray for us!
