


Welcome to the Redemptorist Community of Sacred Heart Catholic Church and School and St. Gerard Mission Redemptorists Serving our Parish Since 1926

Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners

Take a look at your hands. Go on, put down the bulletin, and take a look at your hands. What have those hands been doing this summer? Have they been digging in the soil, planting flowers, pulling up weeds? Have they been holding a book, or cell phone in front of your nose as you lounge around on the beach or at a summer vacation spot? Have they been clacking away at a computer keyboard, the work not stopping for summer? What have your hands been doing?

Monday is Labor Day, the unofficial end of summer. Yes, back to school! On Labor Day we honor the work of the hands of all who labor and we are celebrating the opportunities that we have to rest our hands, even for just a day. We honor the

hands of the assembly line worker, swift and capable. We honor the hands of the teacher, dusted with chalk. We honor the hands of the artist, free-flowing and splattered with paint. We honor the hands of those who once worked, but who now scratch their heads as they circle the want ads, or who twiddle their thumbs contentedly in their retirement. We honor the hands of the stay-at home-parent, always ready to offer a hug. We honor the hands of the surgeon, so skilled and so precise. We honor your hands today for the work your hands do and we celebrate the rest from their labor that some of your hands have enjoyed during these summer months.

In Psalm 90, we hear a prayer to God, "Prosper for us the work of our hands, O prosper the work of our hands!" The writer of the Psalm is asking God to bless all that we do with our hands, to make our work meaningful, no matter what our work is, to make it have lasting effects and to make our hands' work beneficial to others. In asking God to prosper the work of our hands, we are acknowledging that God works through us that our work can reflect God's will for us, meaning that, with the work of our hands we can act justly, love mercy, and that we can show our love for our neighbor that we have for ourselves.

Indeed, in so doing, we might even say that if God blesses our hands in such a way, that we become God's hands in this world, doing God's work. God has entrusted to our hands the work of spreading the Good News, remembering the poor, and serving God by serving others. All that our hands have done this summer... and recall what they have done!... all that our hands have done is God's work done through us in grateful response to what God has done for us. Yet another reason to rejoice this day.

St. Gerard receives Icon of Our Lady of Gietrzwald

On the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed

Virgin Mary, Nelly Chojnowska introduced and presented Our Lady of Gietrzwałd as a gift to the St. Gerard Mission parish community.

In 1877 apparitions to a young Polish girl, 13 year old Justyna Szafryńska in Gietrzwald, Poland began. During the apparition Justyna asked: "What do you want, Holy Mary?" The reply she received was, "I want you to pray the Rosary daily." Our Lady spoke in the local dialect similar to the Polish language. On July 1, Justyna asked:

"Who are You?" and heard in



Nelly's home is only 20 minutes from Gietrzwałd. She says "it is like a second home to me."

reply: "I am the Blessed Virgin Mary of Immaculate Conception." - the very same response she gave to Bernadette Soubirous 20 years previously at Lourdes. The apparitions continued to appear daily for three months.
