


## Diocesan Special Collection THIS WEEKEND-September 14, 2025 Priest Retirement and Priest Care

## Pastor's Corner



#### Dear Parishioners

A long, long time ago, after Jesus had died and risen from the dead, His friends remembered the hill where He was crucified. They remembered the Cross on which He gave His life for all people.

But as years went by, that place was forgotten. Buildings were put up, and no one knew exactly where the Cross of Jesus was anymore.

Three hundred years later, a kind and faithful woman named

**St. Helena**, the mother of Emperor Constantine, wanted to find the Cross of Jesus. She traveled all the way to the Holy Land. She prayed and asked God to help her.

After searching and digging, workers found three old wooden crosses buried near the place of Calvary. But no one knew which one was the Cross of Jesus!

Then something amazing happened. A sick woman was brought to the site. When she touched the first cross, nothing happened. When she touched the second, still nothing. But when she touched the third cross, she was instantly healed! Everyone knew—this was the true Cross of Jesus.

The people were so happy that they lifted the Cross high into the air so everyone could see it. They praised God and shouted with joy. That's why we call today's feast **The Exaltation of the Holy Cross**—because we "lift high" the Cross and honor it, remembering that it is not a symbol of death anymore, but of life, love, and victory.

And ever since then, on this day, **September 14**, Christians all over the world celebrate this feast. We look at the Cross not with sadness, but with love, because it reminds us how much Jesus loves us.

The miracle of the Christian faith is centered in the cross of Christ. In no other world religion is the failure of the Founder celebrated as the high point of his mission and message. The very instrument that marked Christ's failure to establish the Kingdom of God on earth became the symbol of his success in establishing the Kingdom of God in Heaven. The triumph of the cross is a reversal of all the world's values.

Sacrifice is greater than strength.
Peace is greater than conflict.
Suffering is greater than happiness.
Serving is greater than ruling.
Courage is greater than cowardice.
Surrendering is greater than conquering.
Faith is greater than doubt.
Love is greater than hate.
Life is greater than death.

All these reversals come down to one thing. Those who take up the cross of Jesus as their own cross can and will be triumphant. May the prayer of the holy cross be our prayer today: "We adore you O Christ and we praise you, because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world."


