

## Pastor's Corner



Each year, the Catholic Church in the United States designates this weekend, the third Sunday in September, as "Catechetical Sunday"— a day on which to celebrate and pray for the Church's mission to teach the Gospel to all people. The theme for this year, "Always be ready to give an explanation...for a reason for your hope," corresponds with the official theme for the Jubilee Year which is "Pilgrims of Hope." The 2025 theme encourages us to be prepared to share the basis of our faith, the Lord, and the hope He provides.

Each year on Catechetical Sunday, the Church invites us to pause and reflect on the vital mission of handing on the faith. It is a reminder that catechesis—teaching the faith—is not just about classrooms, textbooks, or formal lessons, but about witnessing to Christ with our lives.

The word *catechesis* comes from a Greek word meaning "to echo." A catechist is one who allows the voice of Christ, spoken through Scripture and the Church, to echo in

the hearts of others. On this day, we give thanks for our catechists—those men, women, and young people who dedicate time, patience, and love to help others encounter Jesus. But we are also reminded that every baptized person shares this mission. Parents, grandparents, godparents, friends, and parishioners are called to be living catechists, showing by word and example what it means to be a disciple. We are all called to bear witness for the reason for our hope.

This Sunday is an invitation to ask ourselves: *How do I hand on the faith?* Perhaps it is in teaching a child how to pray, sharing a word of encouragement with someone struggling, or living with integrity and compassion in daily life. The faith is not only taught; it is caught. People believe when they see Christ alive in us.

As we honor and pray for our catechists today, let us also renew our own baptismal calling to be witnesses of the Gospel. May the Holy Spirit strengthen all who teach, guide, and nurture faith in others, so that the echo of God's Word may resound in every heart.

#### SACRED HEART SCHOOL NEWS




August 29th was Data Day led by Mrs. Labreche and Mrs. Hoff. Our teachers participated in "Data Day" and reviewed student progress, analyzed


