

Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners

This week, on October 16th, we celebrate the Feast of St. Gerard Majella, C.Ss.R. I didn't want his feast to pass without some special recognition, especially since my mother - who had a great devotion to St. Gerard, and she prayed to him constantly while pregnant with me - gave me his name as my middle name. I share with you a brief history of his all too short but remarkable and holy life.

St. Gerard was born in Muro, a small town in southern Italy, on April 6, 1726. His father died while Gerard was still young, forcing him to be apprenticed to a tailor. His frail health, quiet disposition, and gentle ways made him an easy target for bullying by fellow workers and employers.

His great love for Jesus crucified caused him to lead a life of self-discipline and self-denial. He applied to the Redemptorists but was rejected because of his poor health. On his insisting, however, he was reluctantly accepted and sent to the novitiate with a note saying, "I am sending you a useless lay brother."

St. Gerard was professed in July 1752, and quickly disproved the prediction of his uselessness by his excellent service as porter, tailor, and sacristan. He quickly gained a reputation for sanctity, which attracted people to him looking for guidance in the spiritual life. He had a remarkable gift for sensing the deep interior reality of a person. He came to be called "The Wonderworker" because of his ability to bring relief to the sick and the poor and of his care for women in childbirth. His reputation as "The Wonderworker" continues to our day.

He died on October 16, 1755 of tuberculosis at the age of only 29, and he was canonized in 1904. Catholics throughout the world honor him as the patron saint of expectant mothers and of families. When anyone asks why St. Gerard Majella and not some other saint of God is invoked by and for mothers-to-be, we can only shrug our shoulders and say that it seems to be part of some secret design of God. Some attribute Gerard's intercession on behalf of mothers and children to a shameful accusation leveled against his chastity. Because of this, they surmise that God has given Gerard a special custody over mothers with child. Some say it was because he was so delicate at his own birth that he had to be baptized that very day — April 6th, 1726. Others, that when a youngster, the Christ-child was his frequent playmate, even giving him gifts to take home; or, because all through his life he showed especial affection for children. From the day of his birth and hasty baptism till his death, St. Gerard was a model of weak health. And yet, for all his spare frame and pale face, it was found that he could do "the work of four."

St. Gerard once remarked: "If anyone, unable to bear the sufferings which God has sent him, call on me for help, or if I hear of such a one, I will pray that God give him the grace of conformity with His Holy Will. That was no idle boast! Nor has St. Gerard reserved his help only for mothers. Thousands from every walk of life have laid their problems before this humble lay-brother and through his intercession have received relief and grace. Your problem may not be his next miracle, but he will not fail you.

We are honored and blessed to have our Mission Church in Edgewater bear his name! In the church there is a beautiful statue of Saint Gerard, along with holy cards and medals. Most especially there is a small relic of St. Gerard! If by some chance you have not been there, I would encourage you to go and pray to St. Gerard. His powerful intercession will hear your prayers! We celebrate Mass there every Sunday at 10am. This week, as we celebrate his feast day, remember him and most especially pray to him!




