



### Pastor's Corner



#### Dear Parishioners

Today we celebrate All Souls Day. And on this day, I always remember a little funny story that was shared with me, a story about a mistake a florist once made. On opening his new shop, the owner received a bouquet of flowers. He became dismayed on reading the enclosed card because it read "Deepest Condolences". While he was wondering about the message, his phone rang. It was from the florist, apologizing for

having sent the wrong card. "Oh, it's alright," said the man. "I am a businessman and I understand how these things can happen." The florist said, "But I accidentally sent your card to the funeral wake." The man asked, "Oh! What did it say?" The florist replied, "Congratulations on your new location."

Certainly it was an awkward mistake, unintentional and no one would be laughing at it. Nonetheless, it may reflect in a certain way, our hope for a departed loved one. We hope and we pray that our departed loved ones would be in heaven and enjoy eternal rest, and are at peace. As we would often hear at funeral wakes – he/she is in a better place, a better location, so to speak.

Somebody said that there was this tombstone in a cemetery that reads: "Take heed my friend in passing by. As you are now, so once was I. As I am now, you soon will be, prepare for death and follow me."

All Souls Day reminds us that death is not a final separation, but a transition to eternal life with Jesus Christ. While we naturally grieve the loss of those we love, this day offers a deep comfort: our departed loved ones are not forgotten. We celebrate the victory of Jesus Christ over death which makes the promise of resurrection and reunion possible for all the faithful.

We pray, too, for the souls in Purgatory, asking God's mercy to purify them and bring them into the fullness of His glory in Heaven. This is an expression of our enduring love and connection. We are all still part of the one family of God—the Church—whether we are on Earth, in Purgatory, or in Heaven.

Our hope is rooted in the resurrection. Therefore, this day isn't just about sadness; it's about confident hope, gratitude for the lives our loved ones lived, and the joyful expectation of the day when, by God's grace, we will all be reunited in the eternal peace and light of Heaven. It's a beautiful, loving reminder that love transcends death.

I close on a lighter note by sharing this with you:

A wife ordered a tombstone for her late husband's grave with this inscription to be written: "Rest in Peace." A few days later, she discovered that her husband had left a part of his Last Will to another woman. Furious, she called up the engraver asking if he could change the inscription on the tombstone. The man replied that "Rest in Peace" had been already inscribed. "Well then," the wife snorted, "Just add: 'Wait Until We Meet Again."

We pray that God will grant our departed loved ones eternal rest in His presence. May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.
