Pastor's Corner



Copiosa Apud Eum Redemptio

Dear Parishioners

Today, November 9th, we Redemptorists celebrate the founding of our Congregation; we are officially 293 years old!

In light of this celebration, I thought that perhaps some of you might often wonder, what are those four letters – C.Ss.R. - after our names on the front of the bulletin? These four letters, "C.Ss.R.," after the name of a Redemptorist stands for *Congregatio*

Sanctissimi Redemptoris. This is the official Latin title given to our religious Order. It can be translated into English as "Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer." More commonly called "Redemptorists." Like the first apostles, our task is to bring the message of salvation to all people. The mission of the Redemptorists is to spread the Gospel to the poor and most abandoned.

The design that you see here and on the bulletin cover is the official seal of the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer. It consists of a cross with a lance and sponge mounted on three hills; on either side of the cross are the abbreviated names of Jesus and Mary; above the cross is an eye sending forth rays; over all a crown. Around the seal is our motto: "With Him is Plentiful Redemption"

The symbolic elements of which it is composed represent the work of Redemption carried out by Jesus Christ and which the Redemptorists are to proclaim under the protection of Mary. This explains the cross on the hill with the lance and sponge, the names of Jesus and Mary and the motto *Copiosa apud eum redemptio*.

The eye is seen as the gracious mercy of God to humanity, divine providence.

The crown over the coat of arms can be interpreted as the crown of glory that is the reward for persevering in one's vocation. The same interpretation of triumph and reward can be given to the palm branches, olive and laurel.

We don't exactly know what motivated St. Alphonsus – the founder of the Redemptorists - and his companions to choose the elements that compose the seal/coat of arms of the Congregation. The chosen symbols, however, really explain themselves as they indicate the purpose and spirituality of the Congregation.

We Redemptorists celebrate the feast of our founder St. Alphonsus on August 1st, and the feast day of our founding today November 9th (1732). Please continue to pray for an increase of vocations in the church, most especially to the Redemptorists. May our most Holy Redeemer bless you abundantly!
