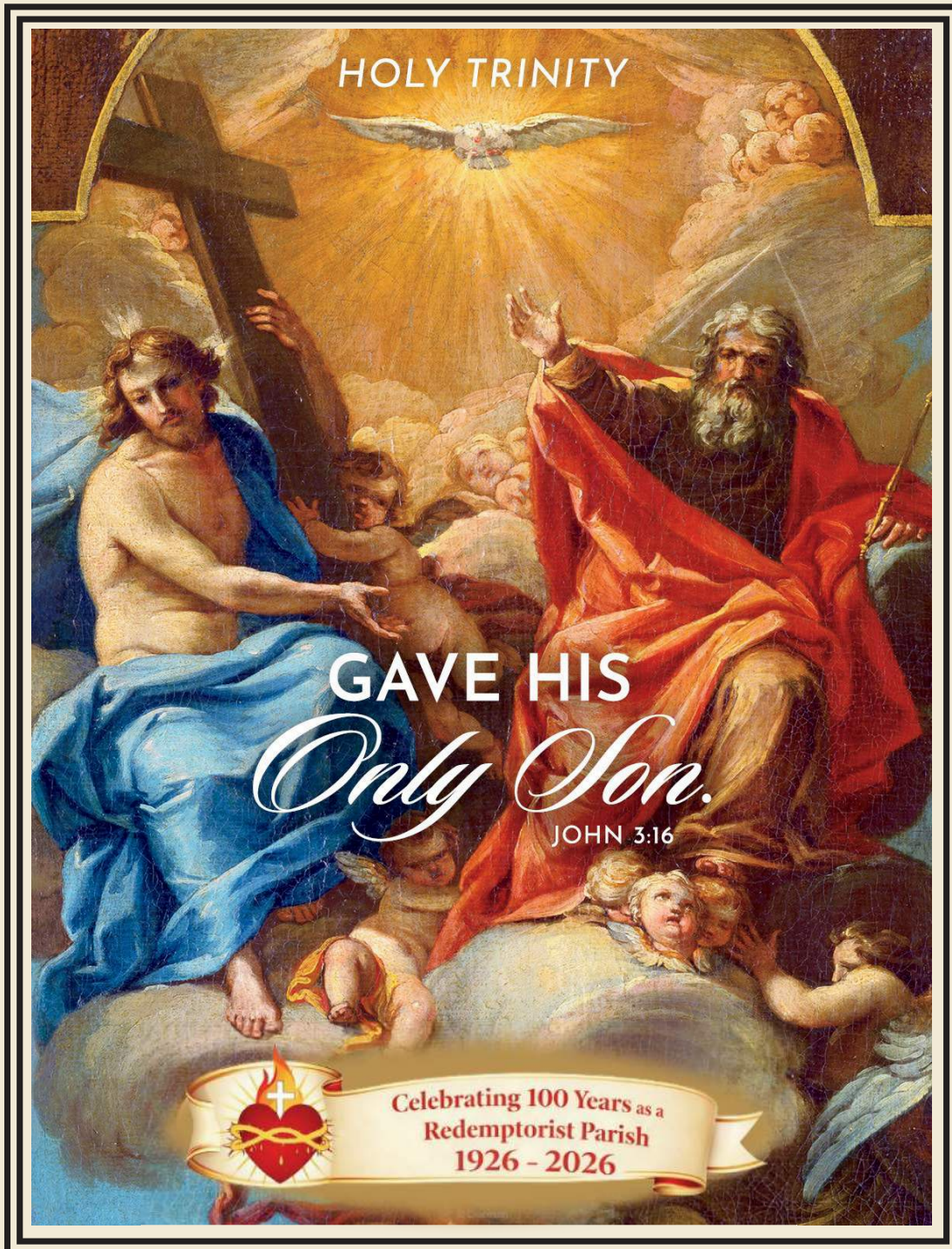

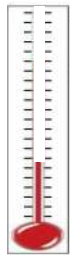
HOLY FATHER / PETER PENCE

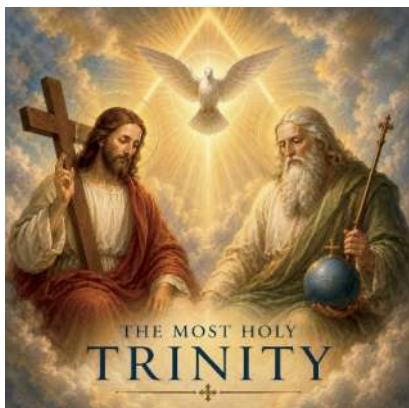

Dear Parishioners

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity — one of the great mysteries of our faith. And if we are honest, it is also one of those Sundays when many priests and parishioners quietly think, “Well... this should be easy to explain!”

The Trinity reminds us that God is not a lonely ruler sitting far away in heaven. God is relationship: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit — a perfect communion of love. Three Persons, one God. Not three gods. Not one God wearing three different hats.

Over the centuries, people have tried to explain the Trinity using shamrocks, eggs, water, and even fidget spinners. None of them work perfectly, but maybe that is the point. Some parts of God are simply bigger than our ability to fit into neat little diagrams or comparisons.

Yet while the Trinity may stretch our minds, it also speaks directly to our hearts. At the center of the universe is love — love shared, love given, love received. We are created in the image of a God who lives in relationship. That is why faith is never meant to be lived alone. We need one another: family, friends, neighbors, and the parish community gathered together week after week.

The Trinity also reminds us that holiness often shows up in ordinary moments. Every time we make the Sign of the Cross, we proclaim this mystery: “In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” It is such a familiar prayer that we can do it almost on autopilot — sometimes while juggling coffee, car keys, and a crying baby. But hidden in that small gesture is the whole story of God’s love for us.

So this week, maybe pause just a little longer when making the Sign of the Cross. Remember that you are embraced by the love of the Father, walked beside by the Son, and strengthened by the Holy Spirit. And, if after all of this the Trinity still feels mysterious... congratulations. You are in very good company with every theologian who has ever lived.

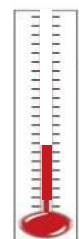

This Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus draws its daily devotions from the Litany of the Sacred Heart. Each day reflects on the wisdom of saints and pontiffs on the Sacred Heart and offers opportunities for prayer and action, framed by Pope Francis’ encyclical Dilexit Nos (He Loved Us) and Pope Leo XIV’s apostolic exhortation Dilexi Te (I Haved Loved You).
