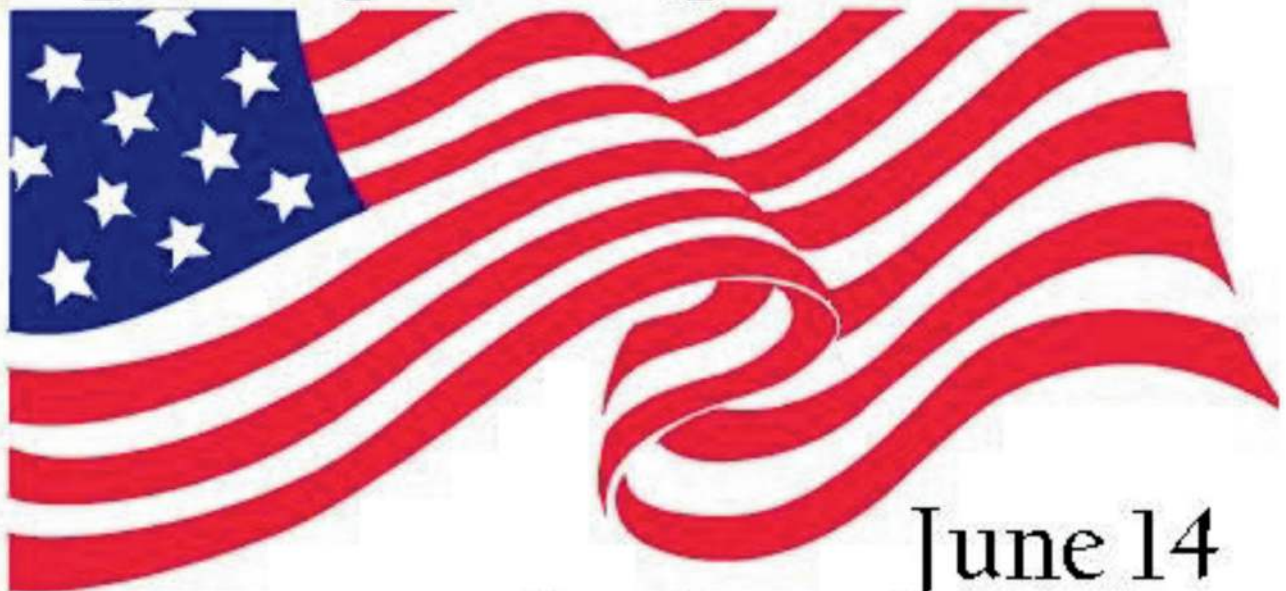

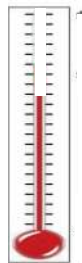

Dear Parishioners

If you walk or drive around our neighborhoods this week, you'll see plenty of crisp, brand-new flags flying high for Flag Day. There is something truly beautiful about a pristine banner that catches the breeze for the very first time.

But if you look closely, you'll also see a few flags that have clearly been around the block. They're the ones that have braved a few heavy Florida downpours, survived a tropical gust of an approaching hurricane wind or two, and maybe have a tiny bit of fraying or fading along the edges.

Honestly? Those are often the most beautiful ones. They tell a story of endurance. They've stood the test of time and stayed flying through it all.

Our spiritual lives can look a lot like those well-loved flags.

Sometimes we come to church feeling like a brand-new banner—everything is crisp, our prayers feel easy, and our faith feels perfectly ironed out. But more often than not, we show up looking a little bit weather-beaten. Life tosses a few storms our way. We carry the wrinkles of daily worries, perhaps some exhaustion, and maybe a few frayed edges from dealing with difficult situations.

Here is the good news: God doesn't require us to be pristine to be useful.

In fact, some of the greatest saints in history were the most weather-beaten people you could ever meet. They had doubts, they made mistakes, and they faced incredible hardships. But like a sturdy flag firmly attached to its flagpole, they stayed anchored to Christ.

This Flag Day, as we look at the banners waving in the breeze, let's take a moment to look at our own hearts. If you're feeling a bit frayed around the edges this week, don't worry. You are still flying, you are still held tight by God's grace, and your story of endurance is a beautiful witness to everyone around you.

Remember also to pray in gratitude for our country, for those who serve and protect it, for those who gave their life protecting it and for the freedom to gather openly in worship. But let us also remember that the strongest witness we can offer is not simply patriotism, but faithful living. A well-folded flag is beautiful, but a life folded daily into God's love is even more inspiring.

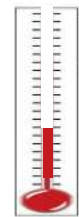
