Parents & Godparents are required to attend a Sacramental Preparation Class. Please call the Parish Office at 428-6426 to register.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Couples wanting to be married at Sacred Heart Parish must be registered and practicing members of this parish. An appointment must be made with one of the parish priests at least six months in advance of the wedding. The Diocese of Orlando requires a marriage preparation program for all couples.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Children who are seven years or older, who have been baptized Roman Catholic, and who have participated in at least one full year of religious education during the previous year may be eligible to prepare for the Sacraments of Eucharist.

Dear Parishioners

Father's Day is one of those wonderful celebrations where ties, grilling tools, and "World's Greatest Dad" coffee mugs suddenly become very important. Somewhere this weekend, a father will proudly unwrap a gift he absolutely did not need and act completely surprised while saying, "Wow! Just what I wanted!" That, friends, is true fatherly love.

Behind the humor, though, Father's Day reminds us of something deeply meaningful. Fathers have an extraordinary calling. They are teachers, protectors, encouragers, chauffeurs, coaches, bug-removers, and occasional experts on absolutely everything—at least according to themselves!
