Dear Parishioners

Most of us have experienced that moment when we are struggling with something and instinctively think, “I wish I could talk to Mom.” There is something comforting about a mother's presence. Even when she cannot solve every problem, simply knowing she is there can make all the difference.

The beloved Icon of **Our Mother of Perpetual Help, whose feast is this weekend, Saturday, June 27th** reminds us of this same comforting truth. In the icon, the Child Jesus looks frightened as He gazes upon the instruments of His future Passion. In His anxiety, He runs to His Mother and grasps her hand. Mary does not appear alarmed or afraid. Instead, she calmly holds her Son, pointing all who look upon the icon toward Him.

The icon is filled with symbolism, but its message is beautifully simple: when life becomes overwhelming, we are never alone. Mary stands beside us, gently leading us to Jesus. She does not draw attention to herself; rather, she helps us place our trust in her Son, who is our true source of strength and hope.

Have you ever noticed that children can ignore advice from their parents, but the moment they are in trouble, they suddenly know exactly where to find Mom? In many ways, we are no different. We sometimes wander far from God, convinced we can handle everything ourselves. Yet when worries, fears, or disappointments arise, we find ourselves reaching for heavenly help.

That is why generations of Catholics have turned to Our Mother of Perpetual Help. Her title reminds us that her care is not occasional or seasonal. It is perpetual—constant, faithful, and enduring. She accompanies us through moments of joy and sorrow, success and failure, certainty and doubt.

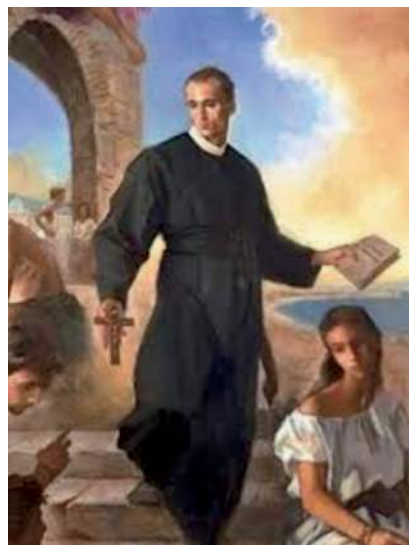

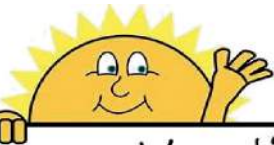
